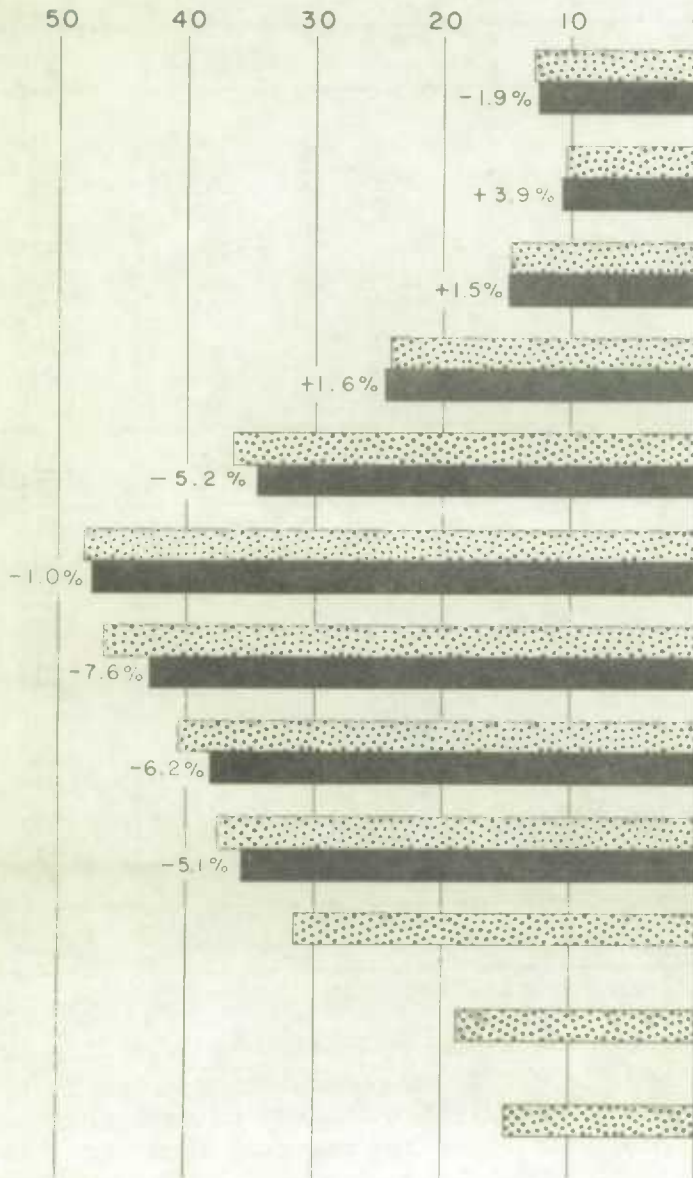

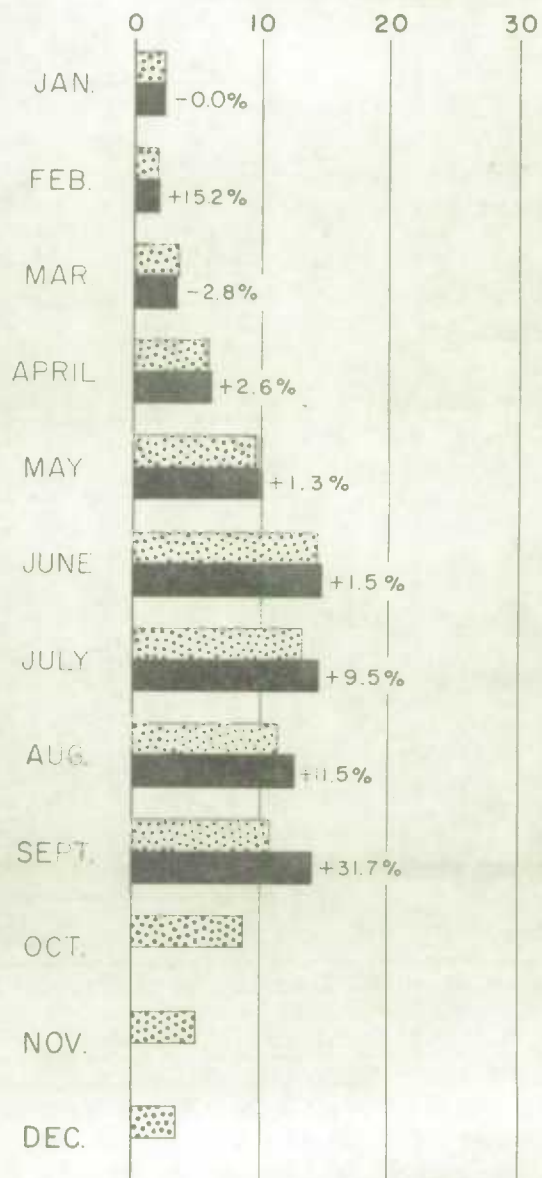

The Domestic Disappearance of Creamery Butter in Canada during September, according to preliminary production and stock data, amounted to 26,702,000 pounds, 4.6 per cent less than the 27,997,000 pounds in September, 1958. Cumulative January to September disappearance of creamery butter, at 220,931,000 pounds was 3.6 per cent less than the 229,097,000 pounds in the corresponding period of 1958.

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during September with the corresponding figure for the last September in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec 14,964,000 lb. (10,656,000 lb.); Ontario 8,937,000 lb. (6,743,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec 11,393,000 lb. (13,003,000 lb.); Ontario 6,184,000 lb. (7,933,000 lb.).
