

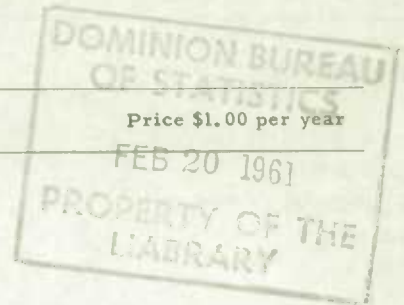

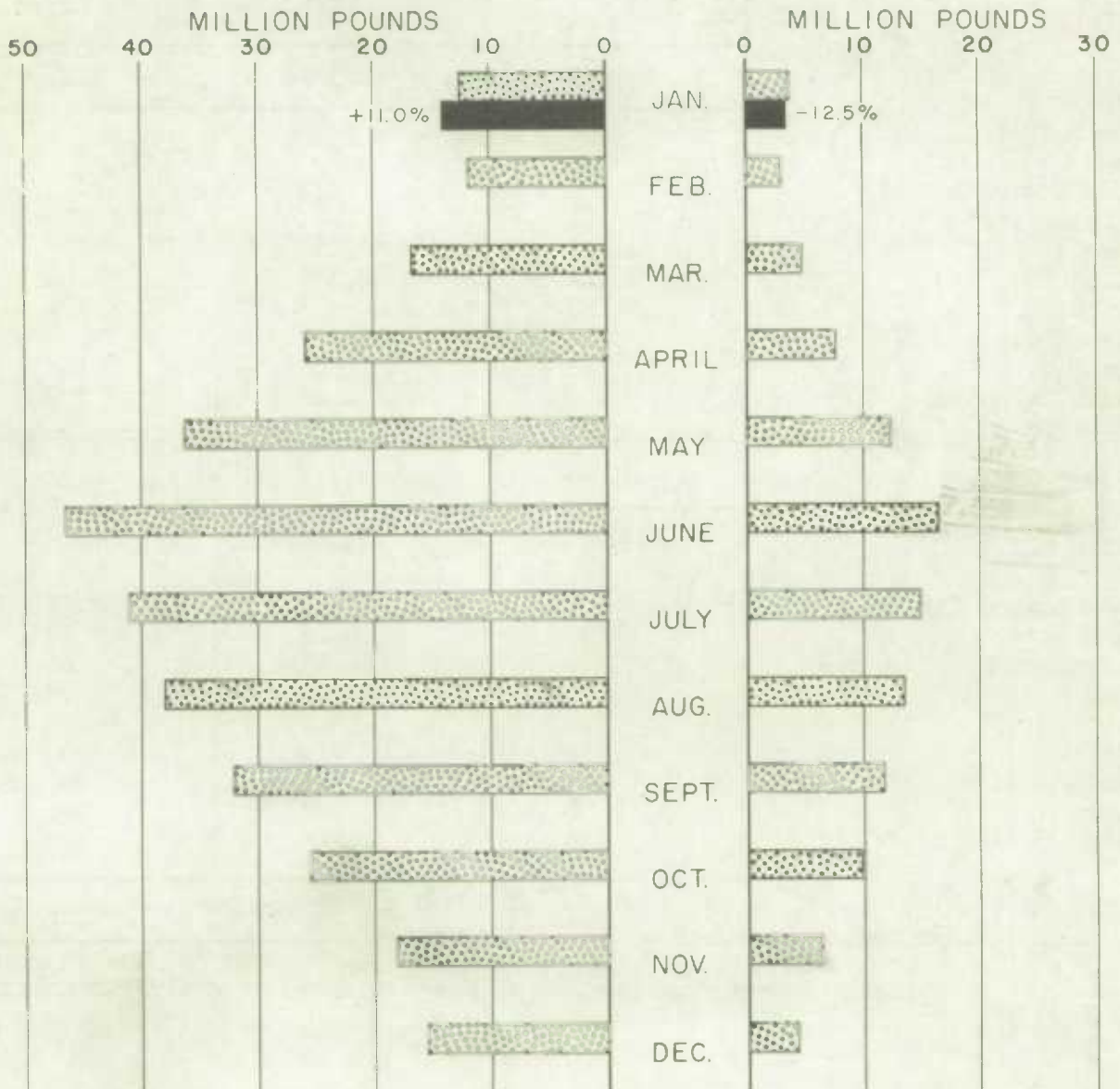

DAIRY FACTORY PRODUCTION

Revised Statistics for 1959 and 1960

In this supplement to "Dairy Factory Production" for January, 1961, revised statistics are shown for 1959 and 1960 by months.

The 1959 factory production figures may be regarded as final data and the yearly totals will be used in the annual "Dairy Statistics 1960" and other publications of the Bureau in which production figures appear.

Data for 1960, being revised, differ from those published in the monthly issues of "Dairy Factory Production". These statistics are subject to further revision at the end of 1961 when final and complete figures will be published. The figures shown in these tables, by months, will be used for comparative purposes in publications issued in 1961.
