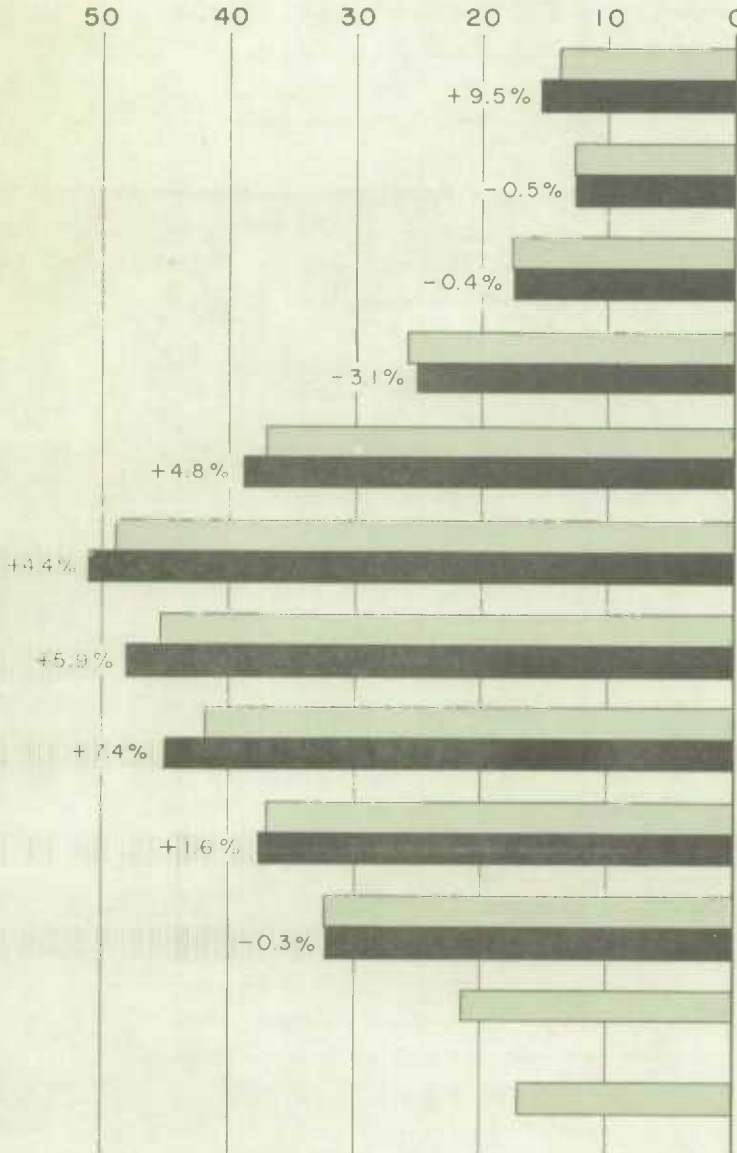

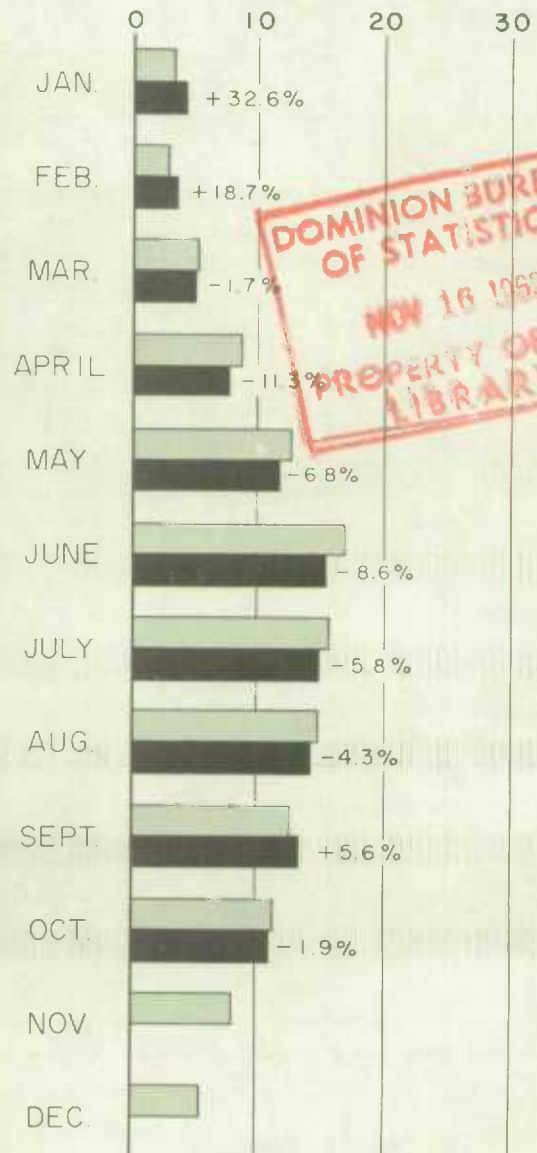

(9,648,000 lb.); Ontario, 9,066,000 lb. (8,705,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 8,186,000 lb. (11,029,000 lb.); Ontario, 6,752,000 lb. (7,815,000 lb.).
