

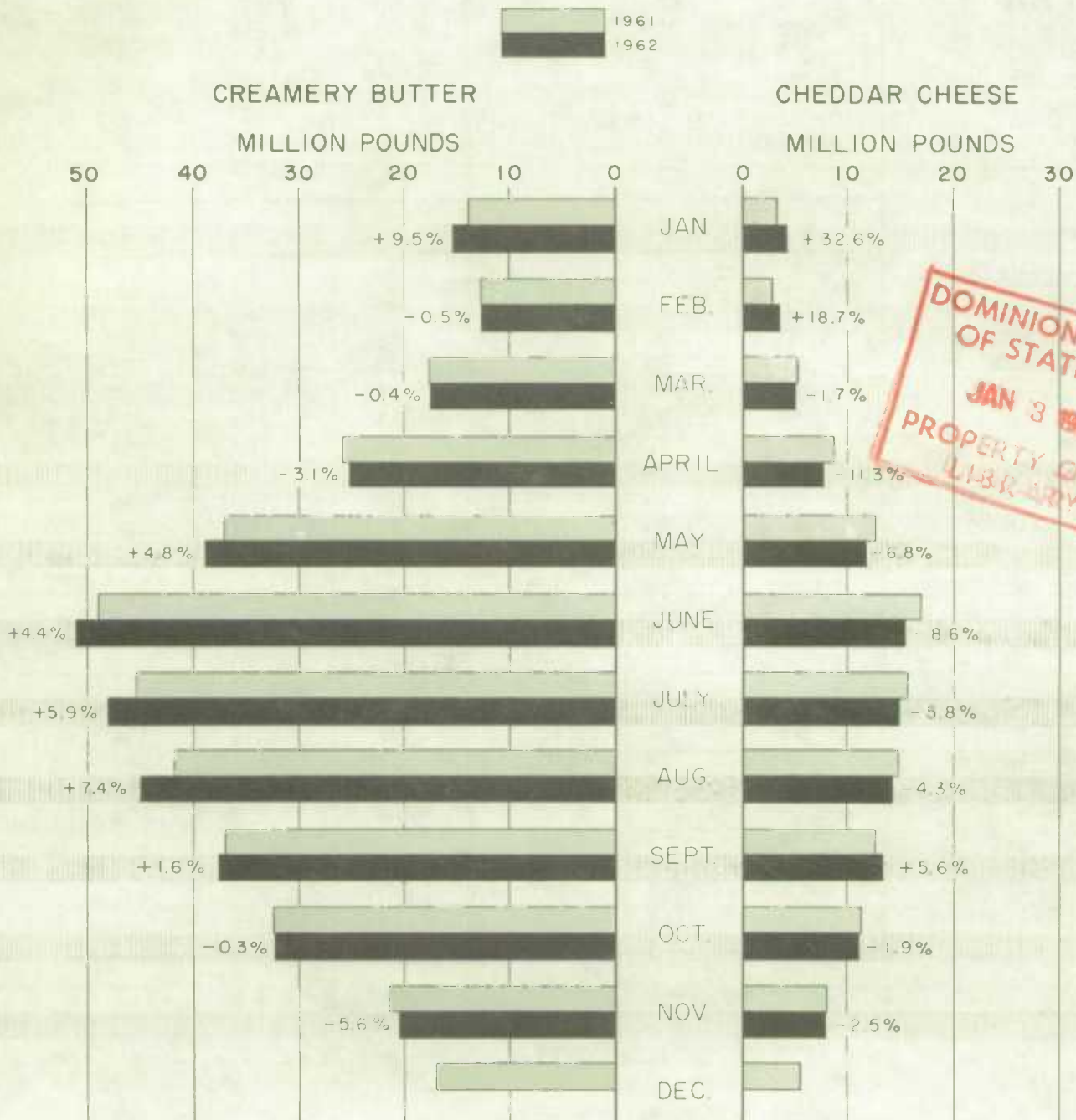

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during November, with the corresponding figure for the last November in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 3,544,000 lb. (6,236,000 lb.); Ontario, 6,739,000 lb. (6,849,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec 4,989,000 lb. (4,976,000 lb.); Ontario, 5,073,000 lb. (5,288,000 lb.).
