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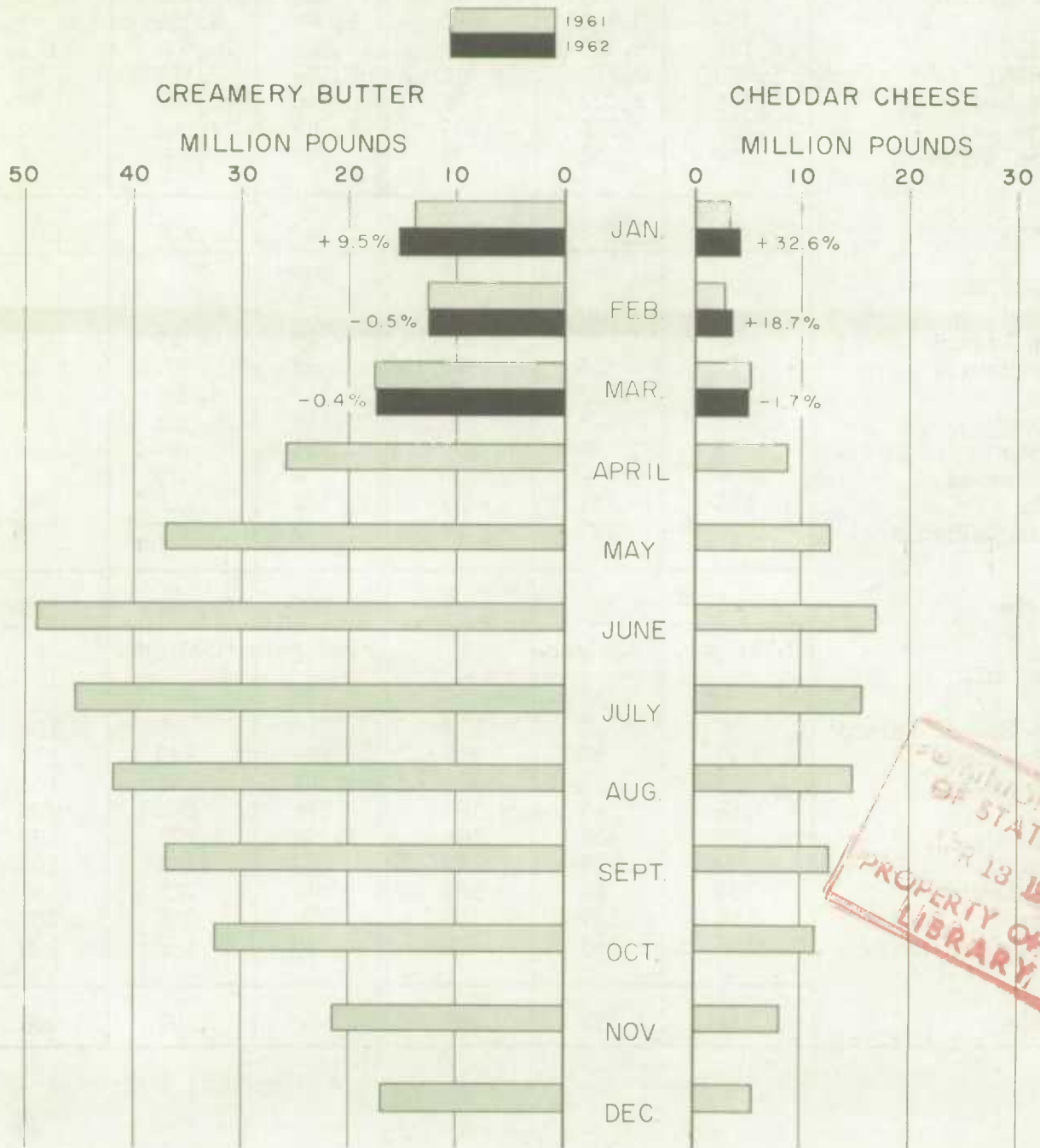

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during March, with the corresponding figure for the last March in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec 3,972,000 lb. (6,440,000 lb.); Ontario 6,025,000 lb. (8,676,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec 3,171,000 lb. (3,904,000 lb.); Ontario 5,334,000 lb. (6,801,000 lb.).
