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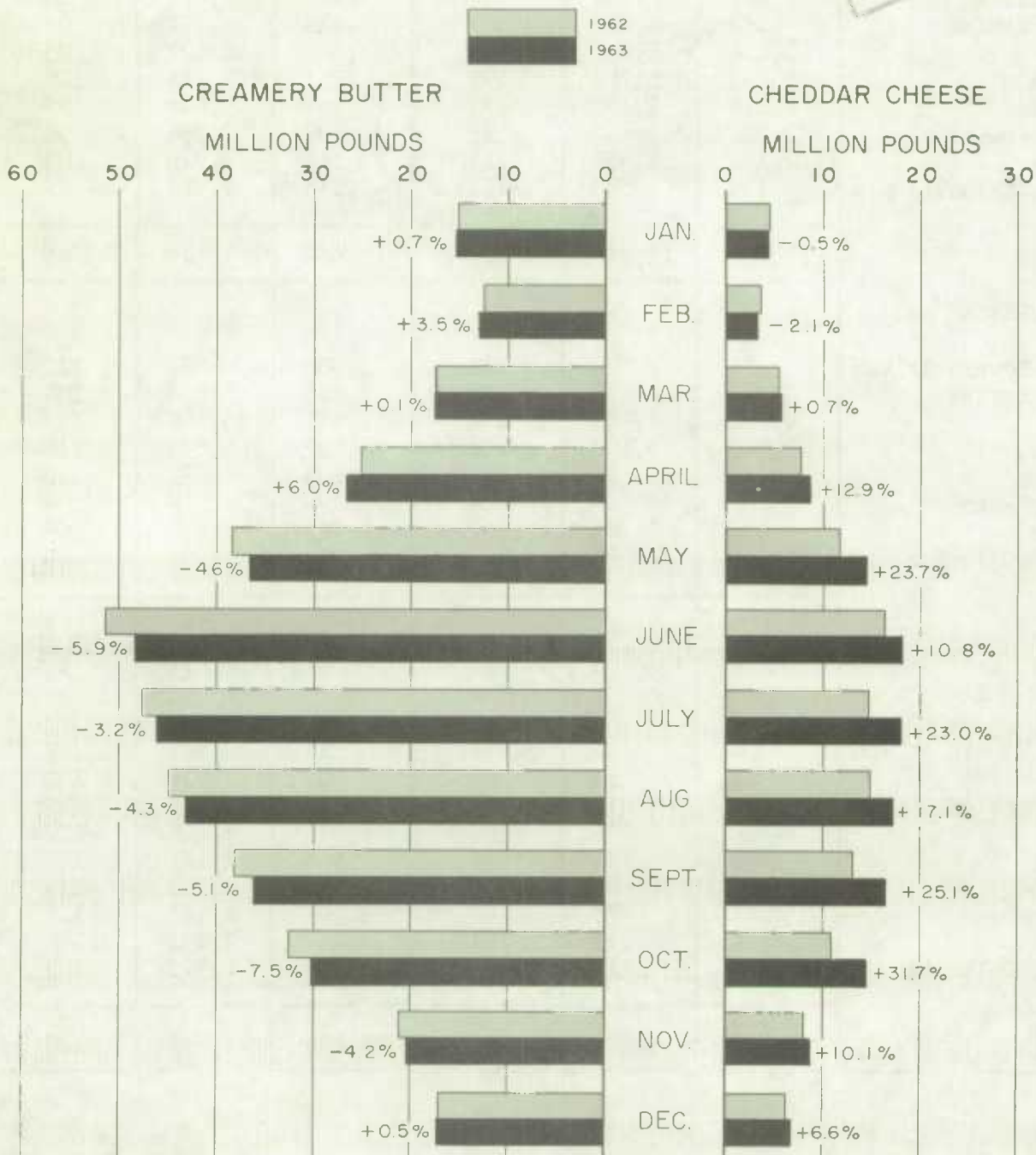

(2,873,000 lb.); Ontario, 7,481,000 lb. (5,952,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 4,850,000 lb. (3,284,000 lb.); Ontario, 4,608,000 lb. (5,195,000 lb.).
