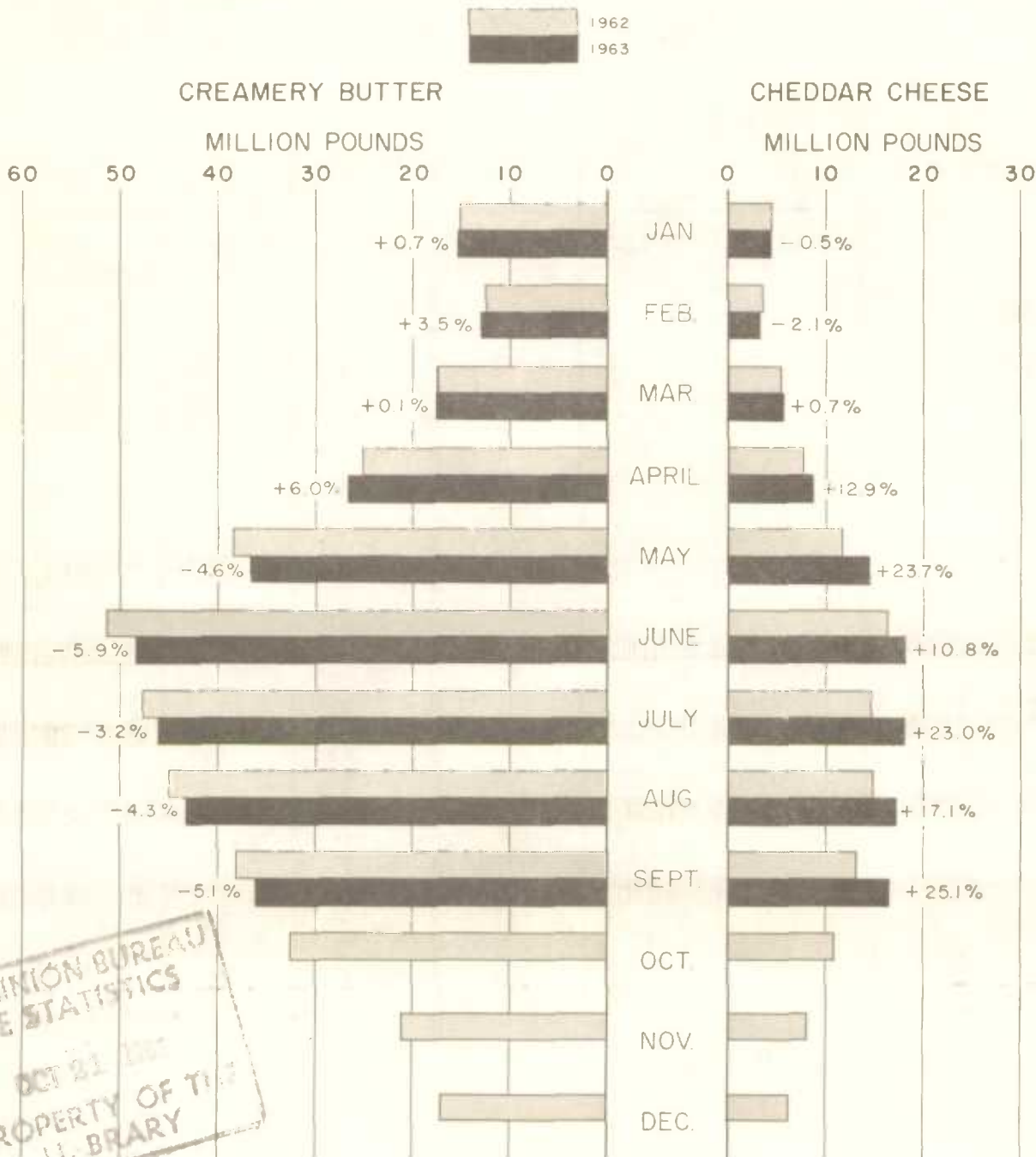

(8,379,000 lb.); Ontario, 10,411,000 lb. (10,530,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 9,400,000 lb. (10,246,000 lb.); Ontario, 7,870,000 lb. (8,893,000 lb.).
