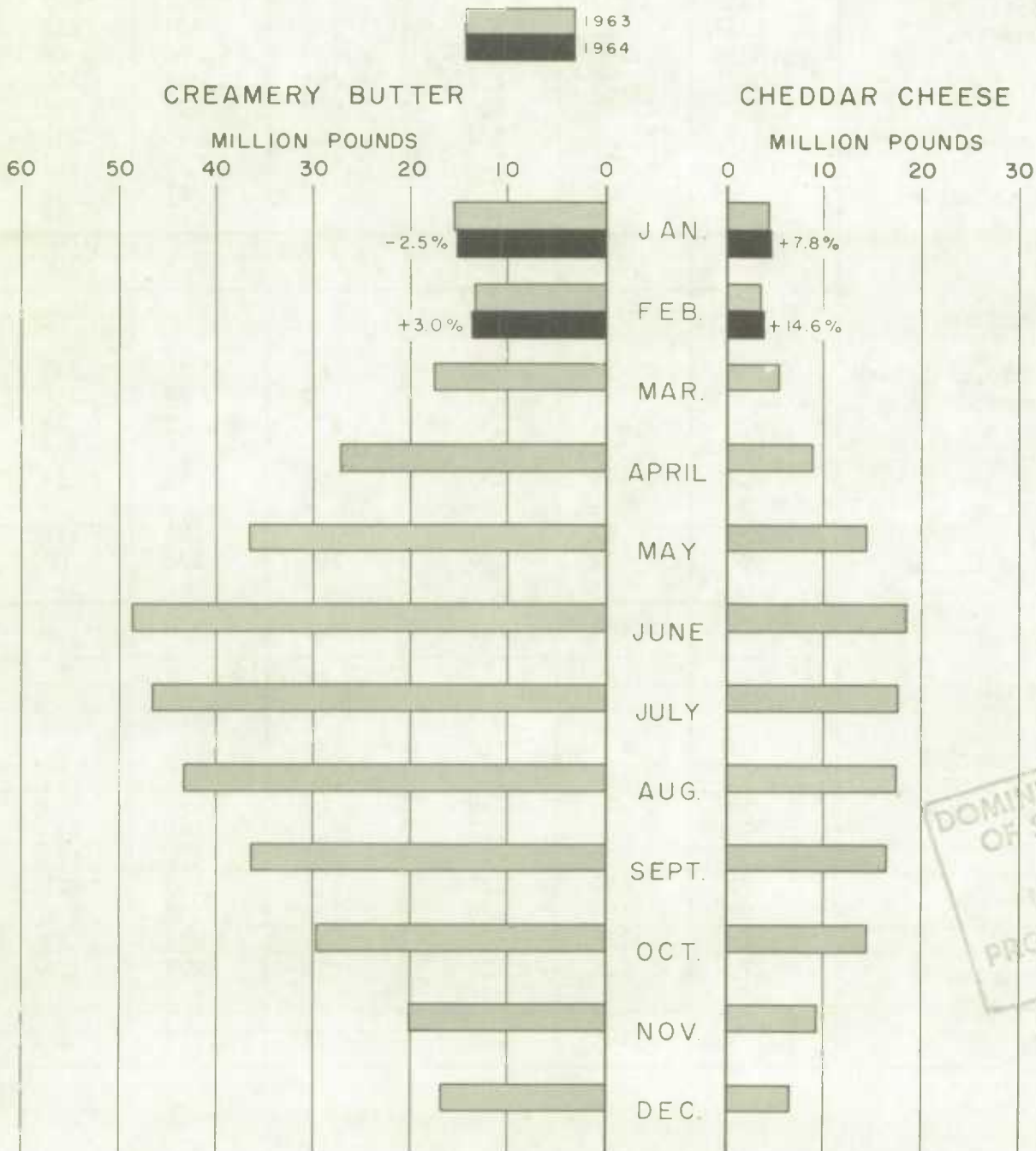

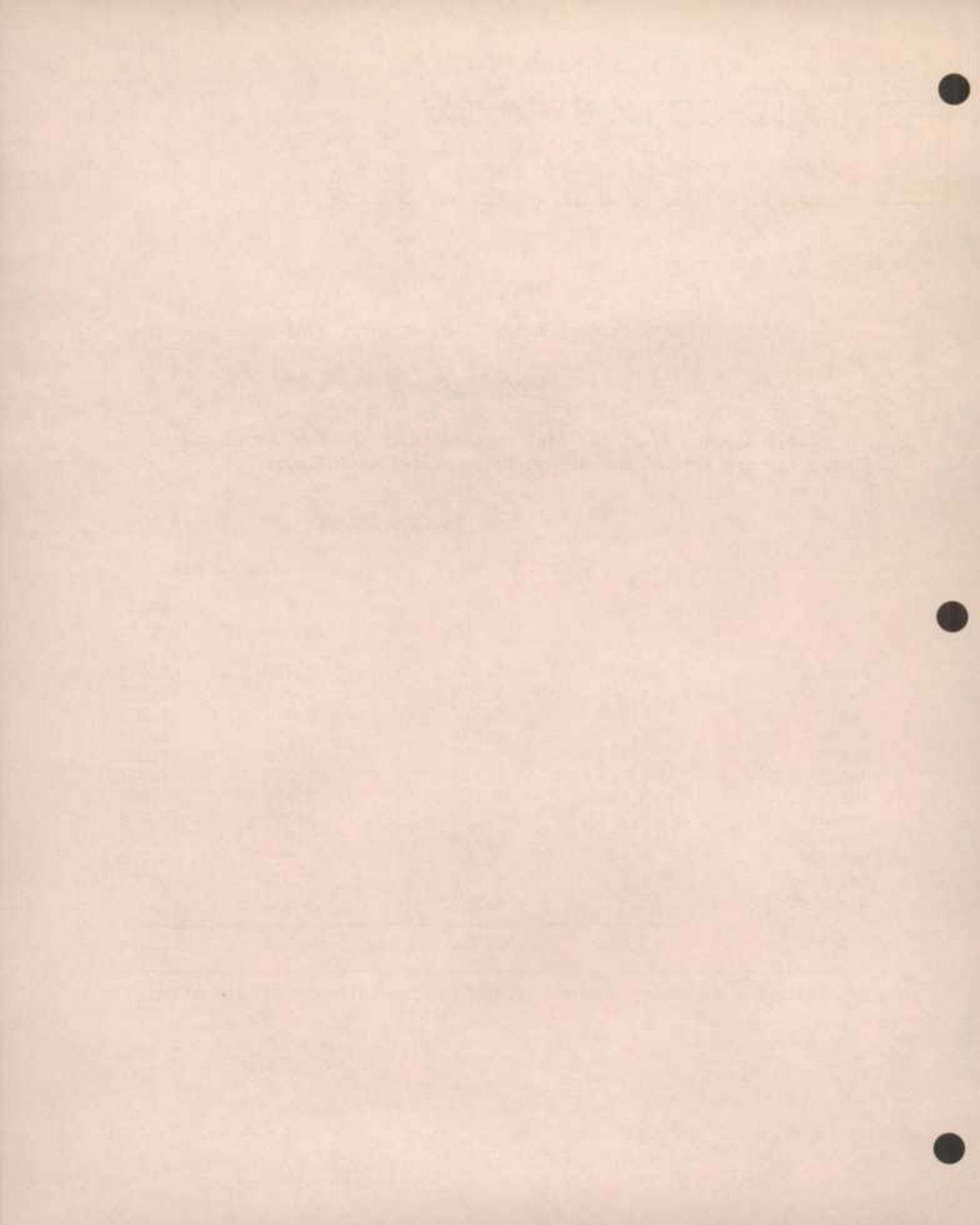

(1,872,000 lb.); Ontario, 7,408,000 lb. (5,773,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 2,402,000 lb. (1,906,000 lb.); Ontario, 4,914,000 lb. (4,230,000 lb.).
