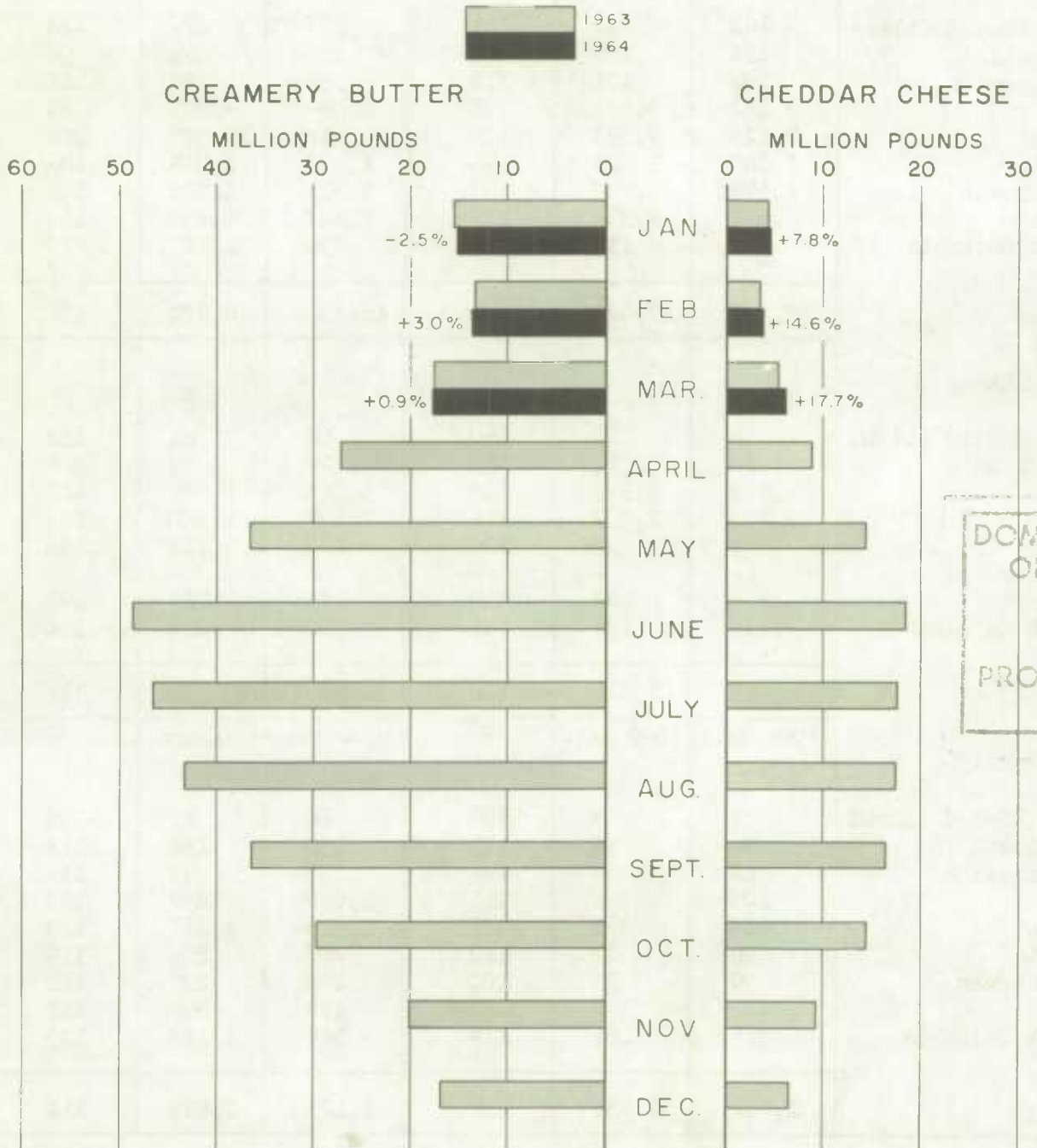

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during March with the corresponding figure for the last March in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 3,590,000 lb. (3,736,000 lb.); Ontario, 10,188,000 lb. (7,076,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 3,557,000 lb. (2,769,000 lb.); Ontario, 6,309,000 lb. (5,946,000 lb.).
