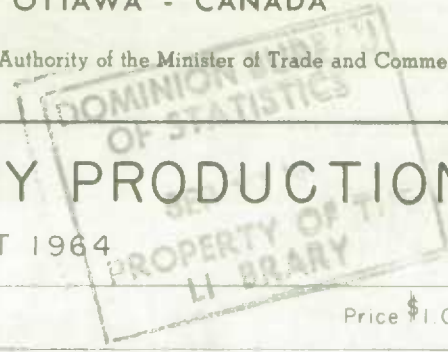

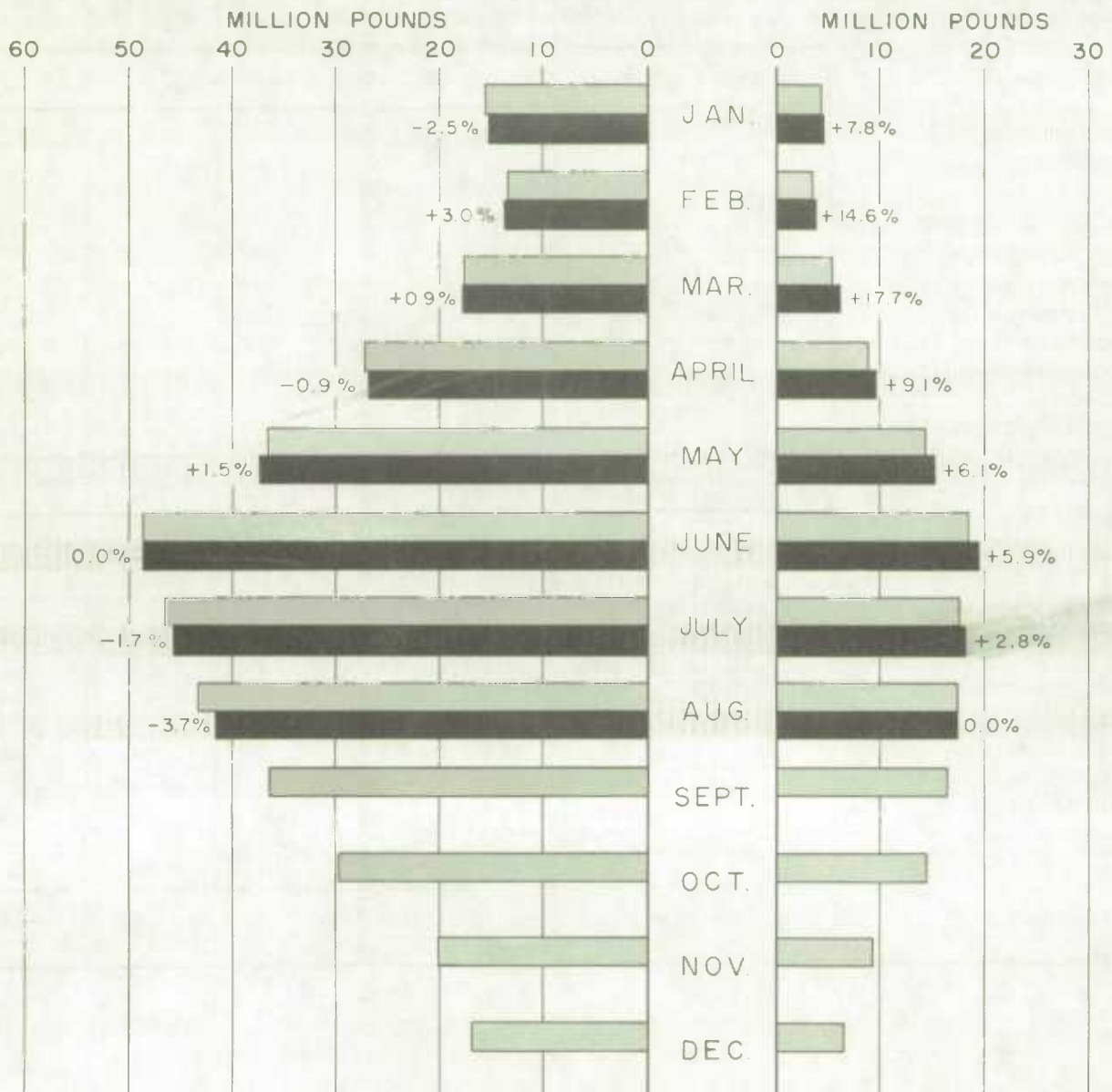

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during August with the corresponding figure for the last August in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 8,990,000 lb. (9,101,000 lb.); Ontario, 11,111,000 lb. (12,102,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 11,478,000 lb. (9,607,000 lb.); Ontario, 11,309,000 lb. (9,719,000 lb.)
