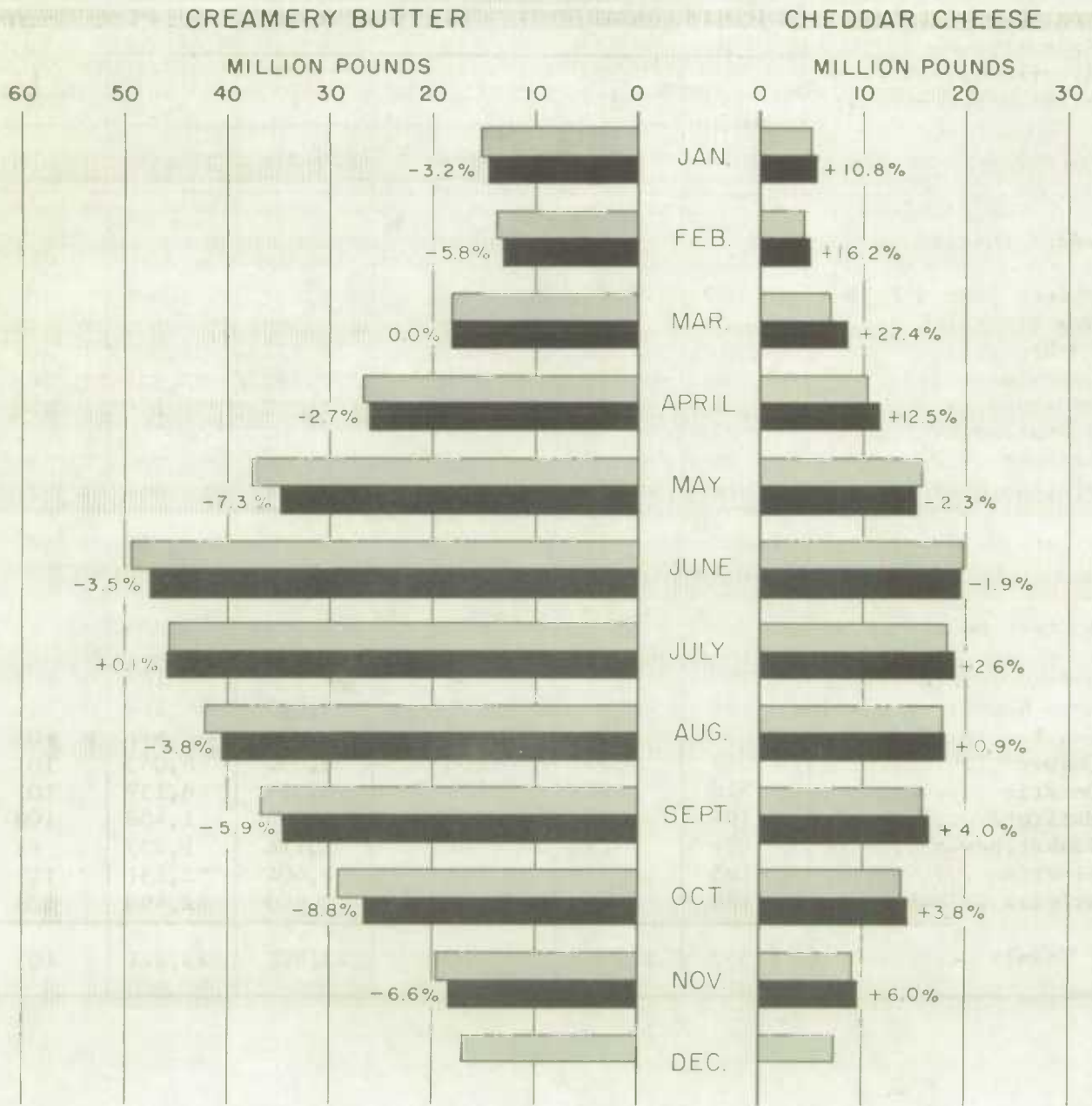

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during November with the corresponding figure for last November in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 5,243,000 lb. (4,557,000 lb.); Ontario, 7,364,000 lb. (6,353,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 6,246,000 lb. (4,846,000 lb.); Ontario, 5,109,000 lb. (5,605,000 lb.).
