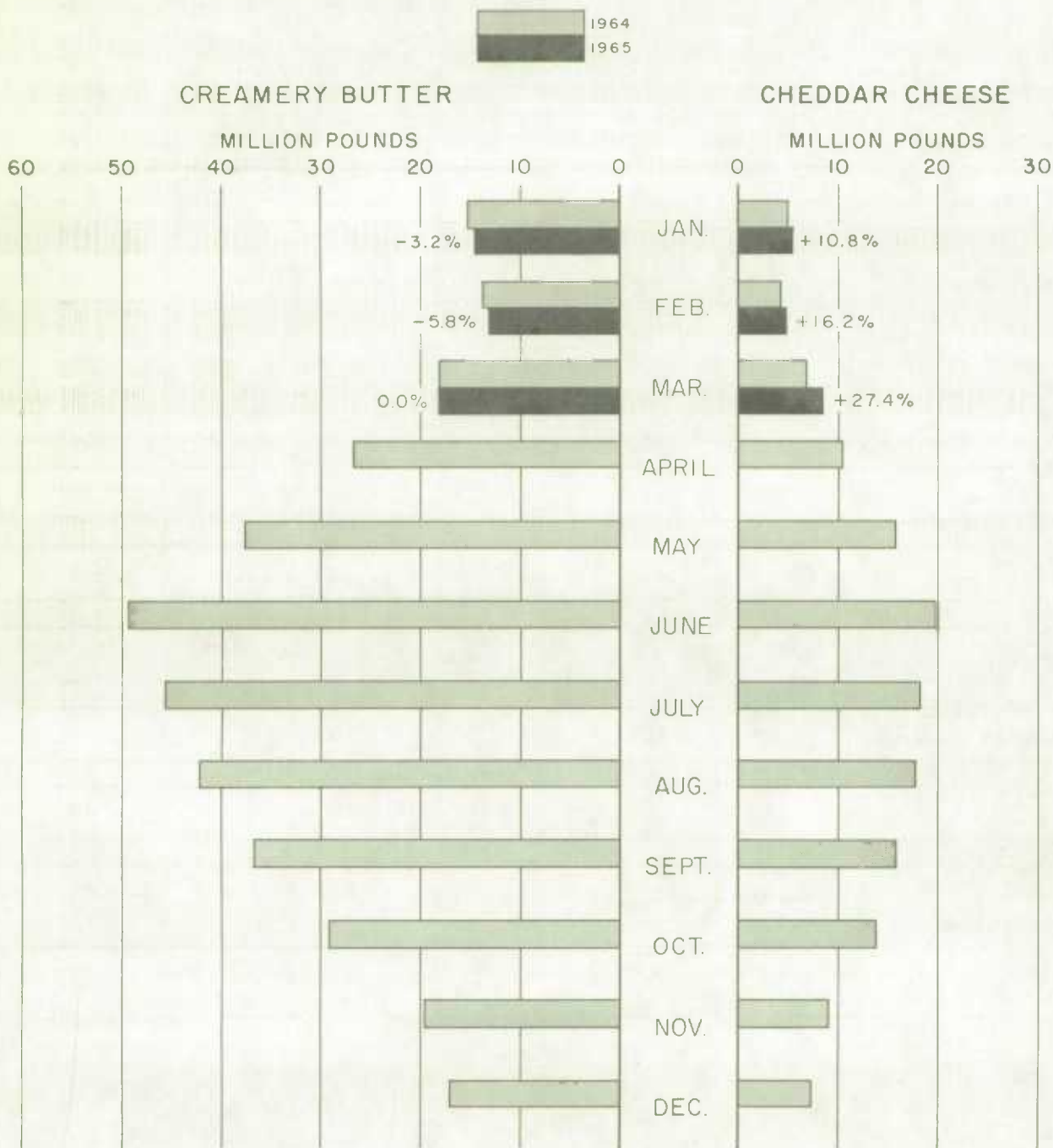

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during March with the corresponding figure for the last March in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 5,077,000 lb. (4,559,000 lb.); Ontario, 9,679,000 lb. (10,188,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 4,461,000 lb. (3,610,000 lb.); Ontario, 6,834,000 lb. (6,411,000 lb.).
