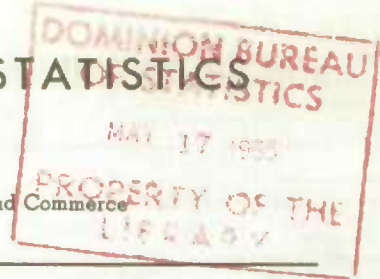

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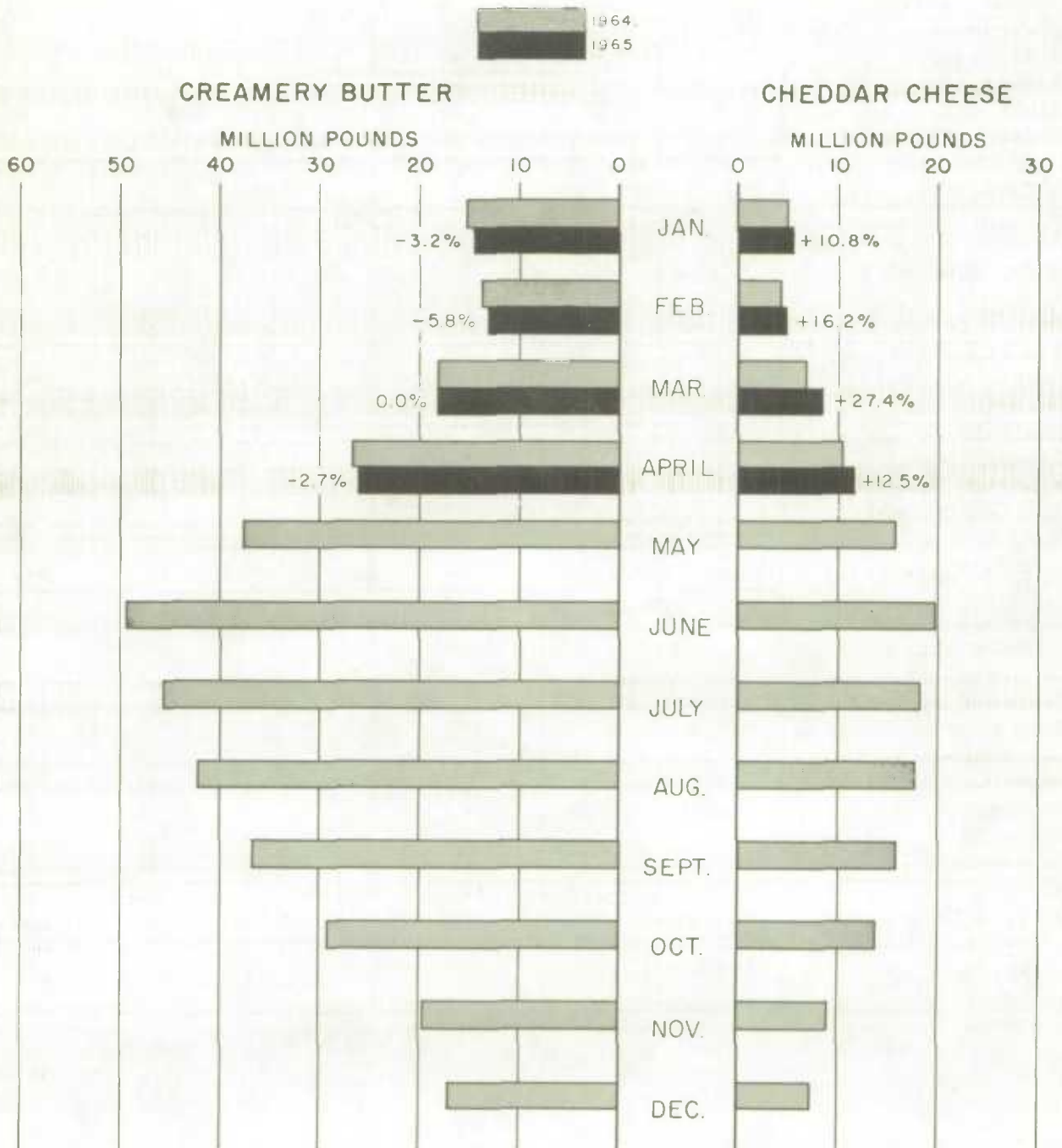

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during April with the corresponding figure for the last April in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 7,082,000 lb. (5,990,000 lb.); Ontario, 10,955,000 lb. (11,305,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 8,008,000 lb. (6,458,000 lb.); Ontario, 8,528,000 lb. (8,981,000 lb.).
