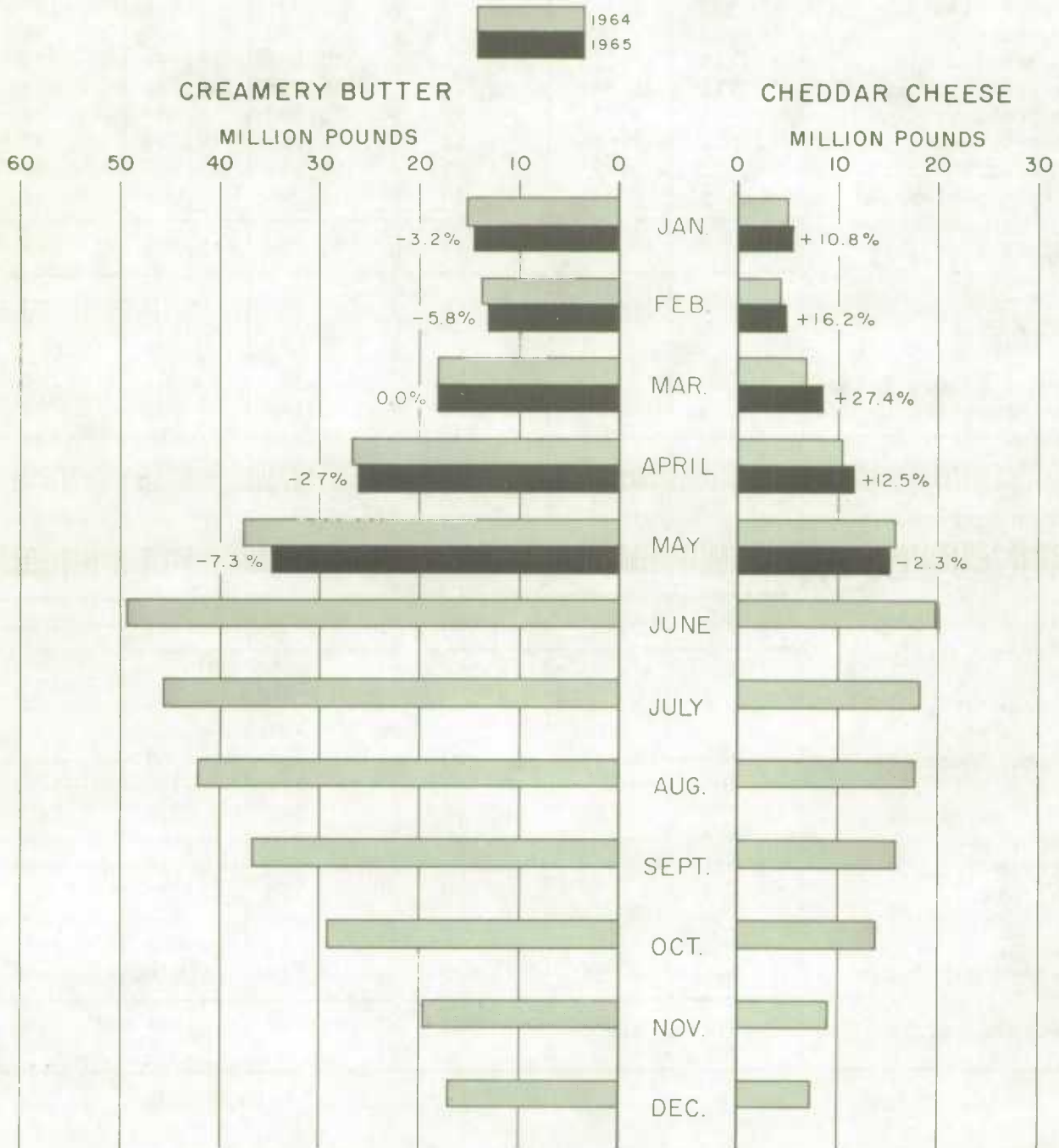

(10,923,000 lb.); Ontario, 11,838,000 lb. (13,695,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 11,092,000 lb. (9,876,000 lb.); Ontario, 11,192,000 lb. (10,863,000 lb.).
