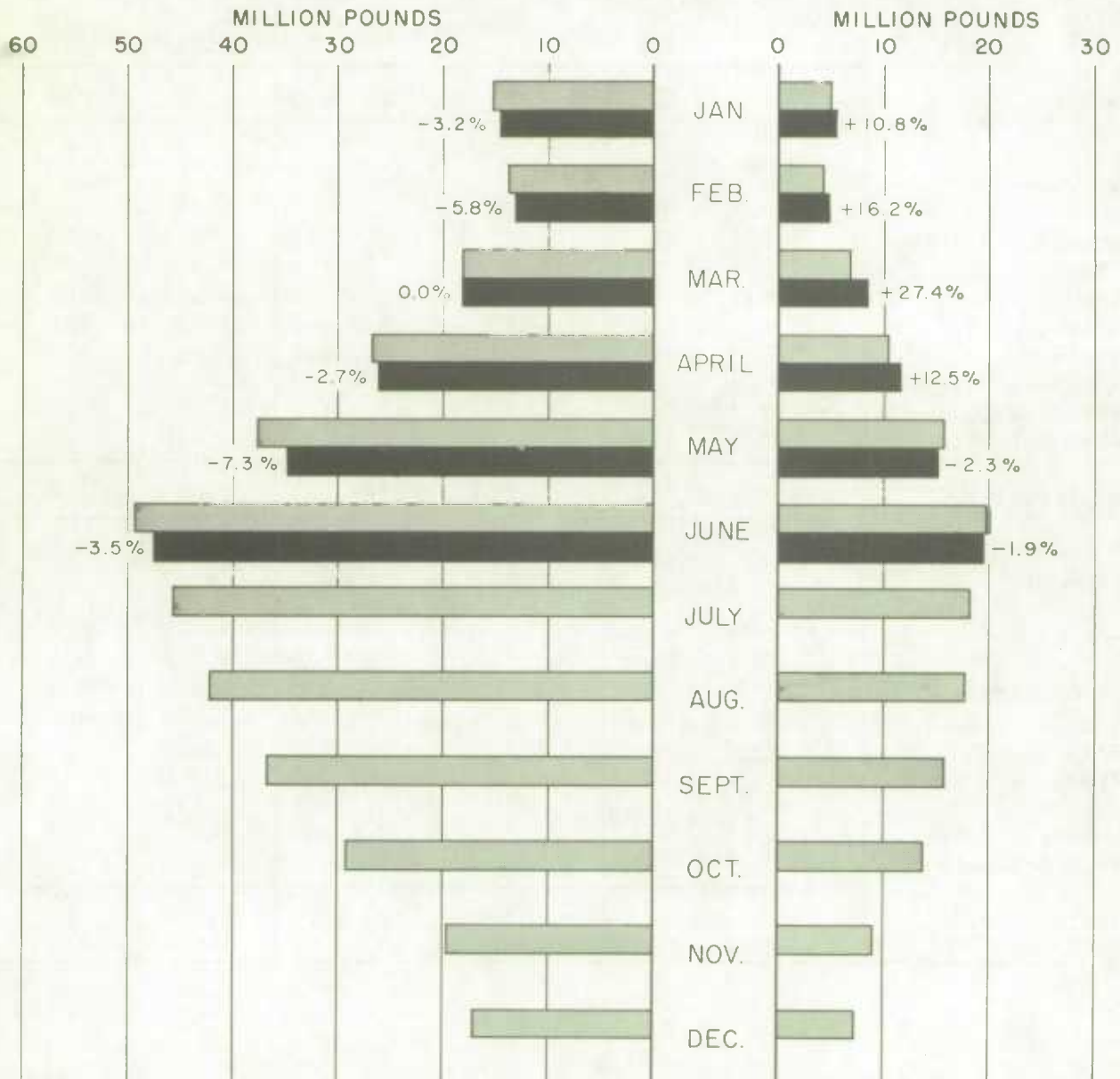

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during June with the corresponding figure for the last June in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 10,687,000 lb. (15,621,000 lb.); Ontario, 15,231,000 lb. (15,440,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 16,899,000 lb. (13,196,000 lb.); Ontario, 13,760,000 lb. (12,994,000 lb.).
