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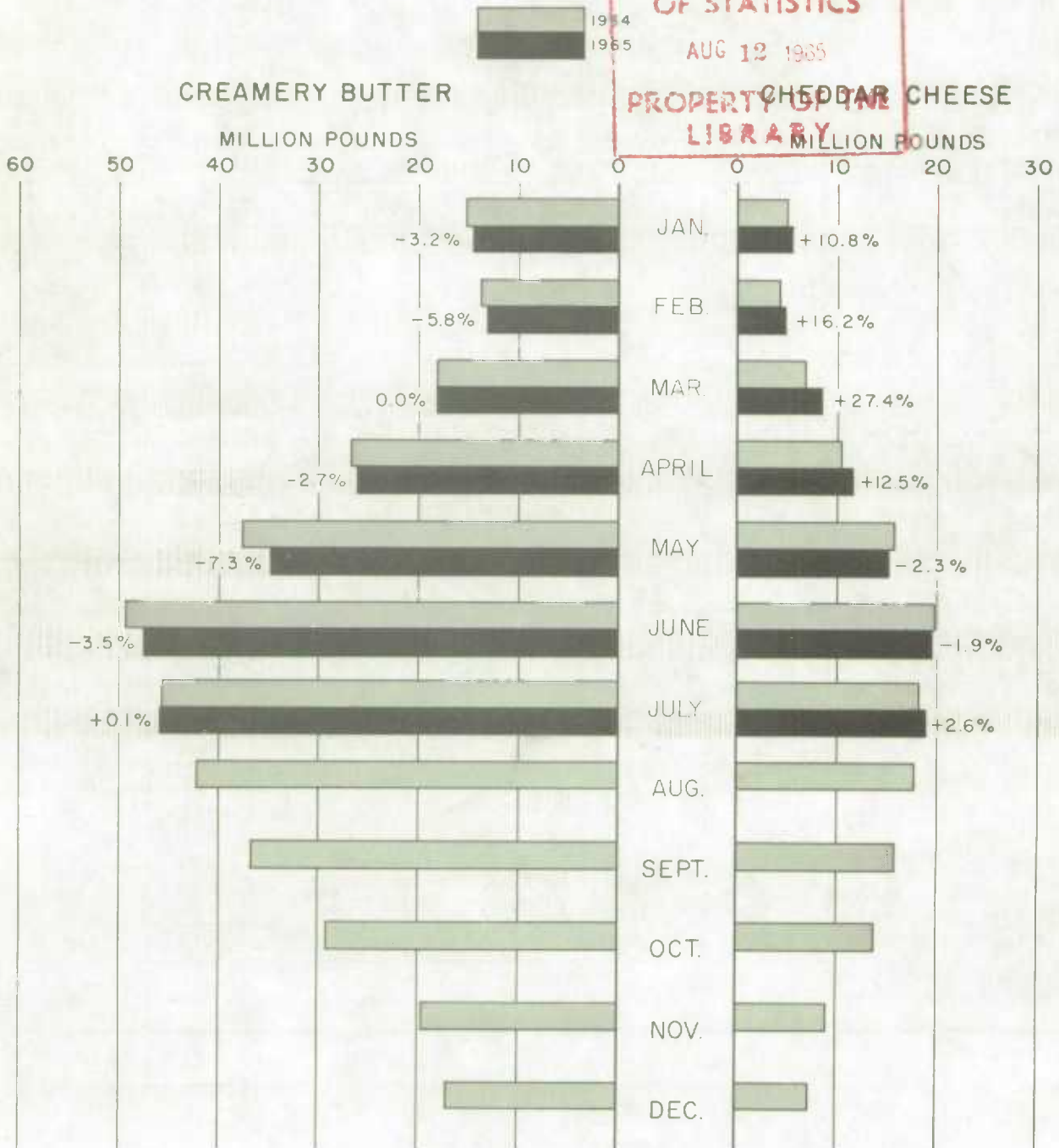

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during July with the corresponding figure for the last July in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 10,106,000 lb. (10,004,000 lb.); Ontario, 12,684,000 lb. (11,440,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 15,503,000 lb. (12,517,000 lb.); Ontario, 12,500,000 lb. (10,966,000 lb.).
