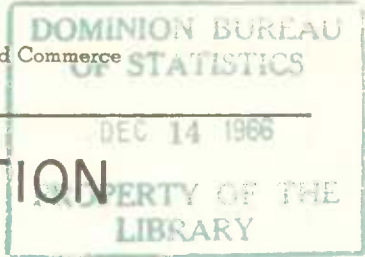

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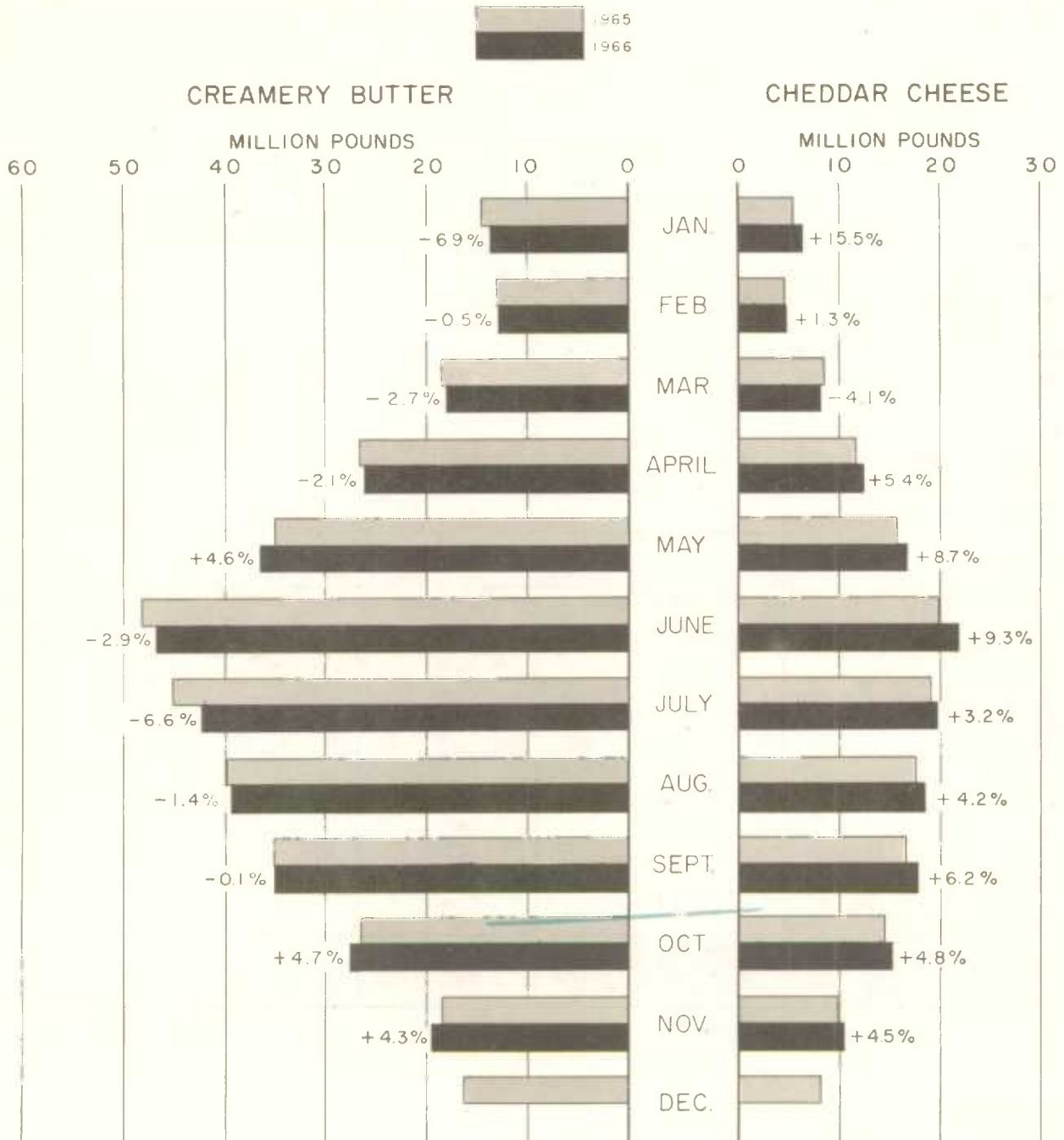

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during November with the corresponding figure for the last November in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 4,293,000 lb. (5,243,000 lb.); Ontario, 6,246,000 lb. (7,364,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 9,424,000 lb. (6,048,000 lb.); Ontario, 5,343,000 lb. (4,957,000 lb.).
