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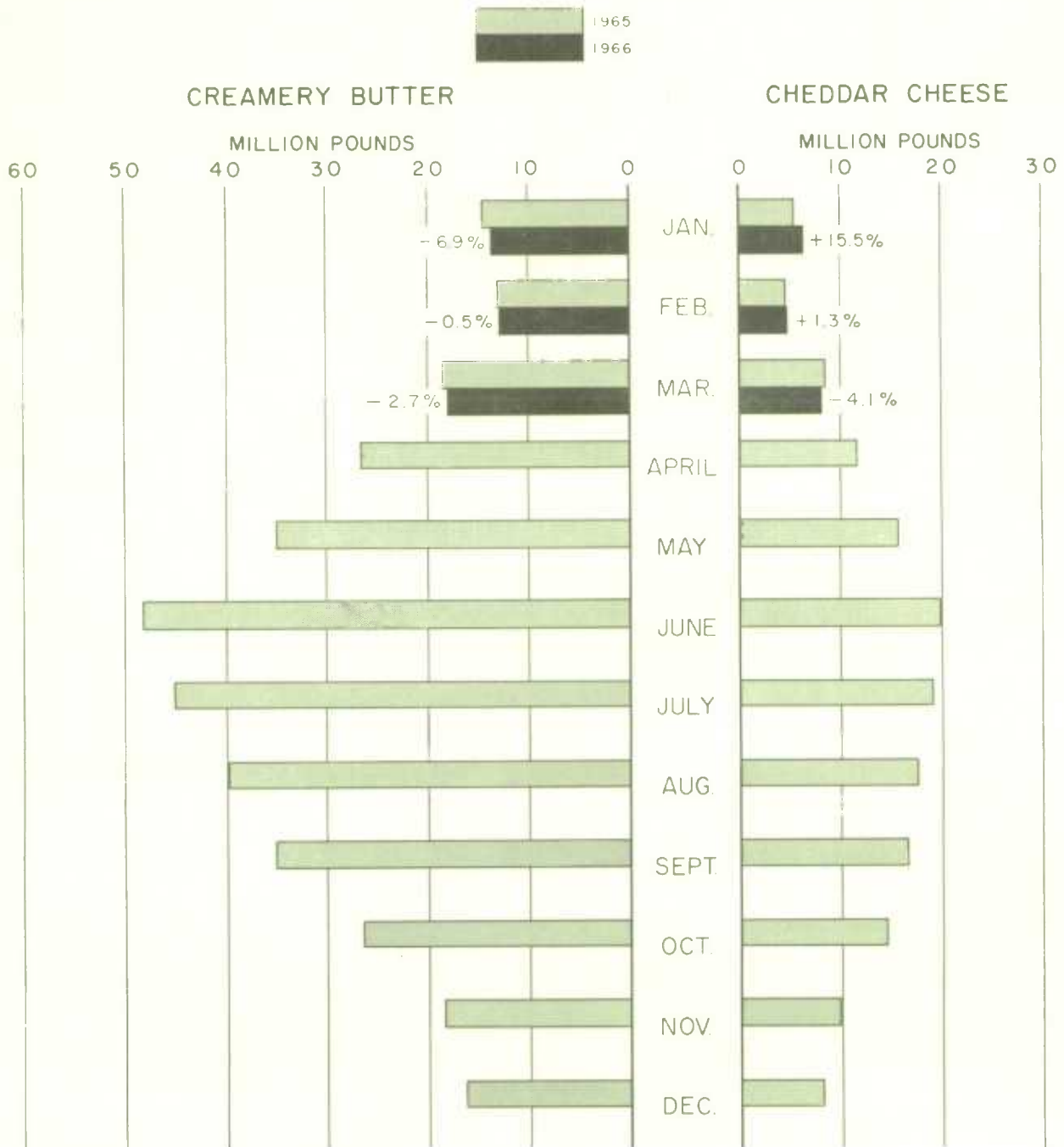

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during March with the corresponding figure for the last March in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 4,975,000 lb. (5,077,000 lb.); Ontario, 9,996,000 lb. (9,679,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 5,683,000 lb. (4,613,000 lb.); Ontario, 7,032,000 lb. (6,756,000 lb.).
