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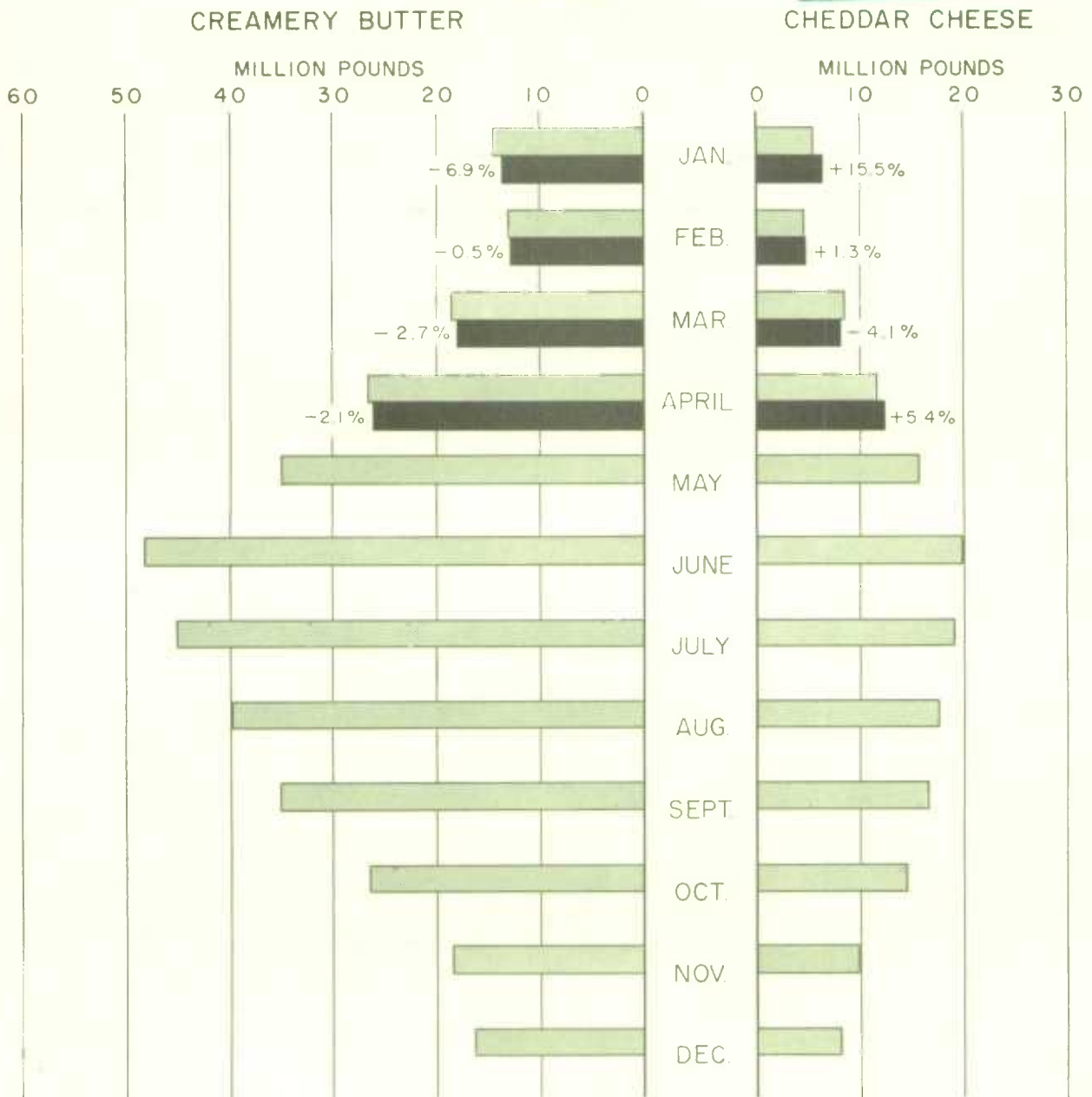
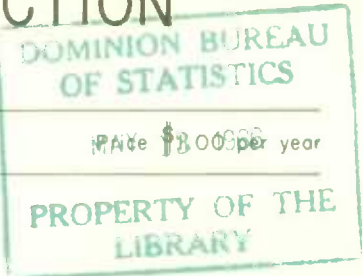

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during April with the corresponding figure for the last April in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 5,964,000 lb. (7,185,000 lb.); Ontario, 10,608,000 lb. (10,955,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 10,539,000 lb. (8,284,000 lb.); Ontario, 9,651,000 lb. (8,733,000 lb.).
