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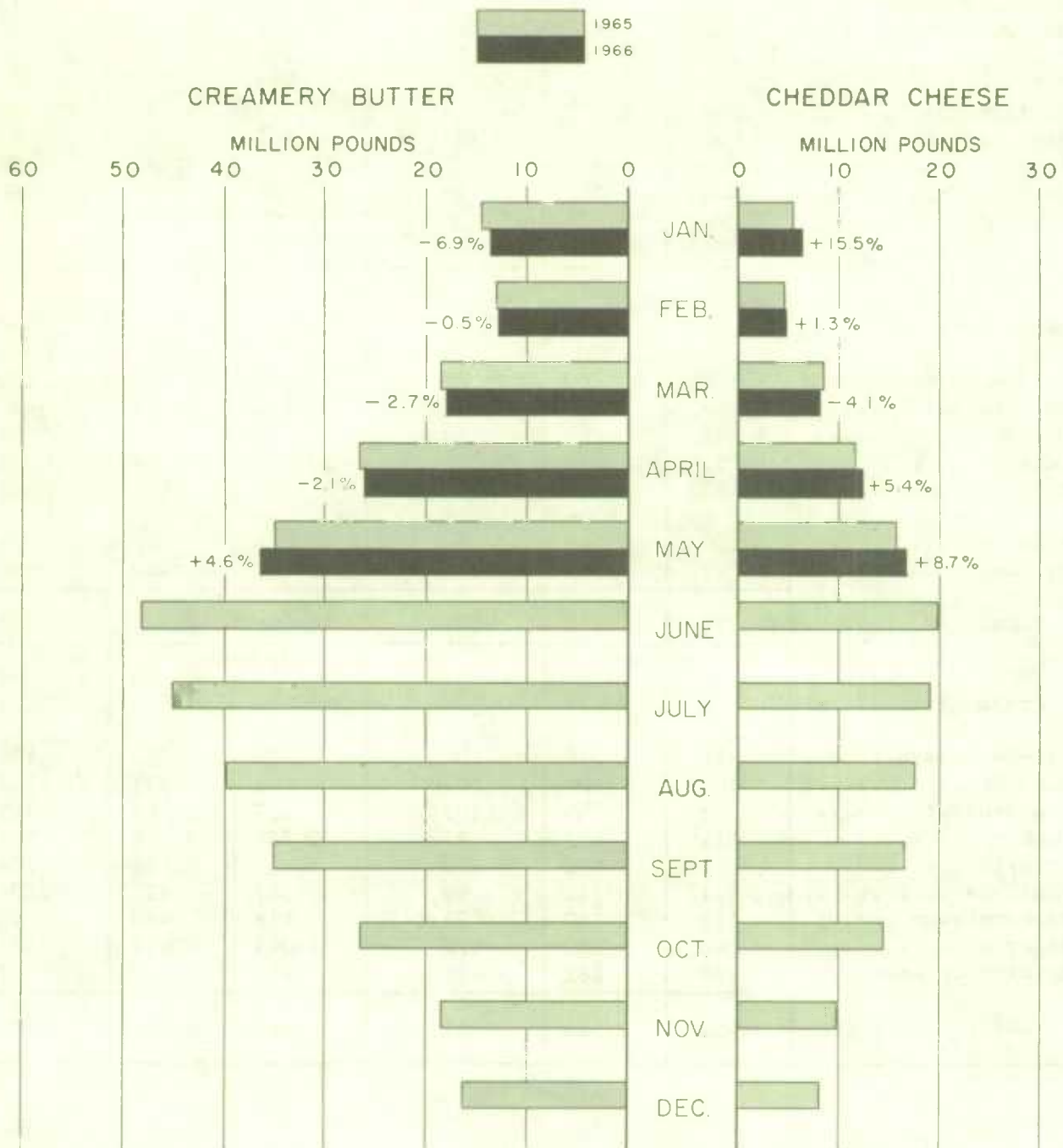

(9,958,000 lb.); Ontario, 11,617,000 lb. (11,838,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 14,982,000 lb. (11,758,000 lb.); Ontario, 11,675,000 lb. (11,078,000 lb.).
