


Production of evaporated whole milk and skim powder in Quebec and Ontario during June with the corresponding figure for the last June in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 11,323,000 lb. (10,771,000 lb.); Ontario, 13,336,000 lb. (15,231,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 19,900,000 lb. (17,509,000 lb.); Ontario, 14,417,000 lb. (13,833,000 lb.).
