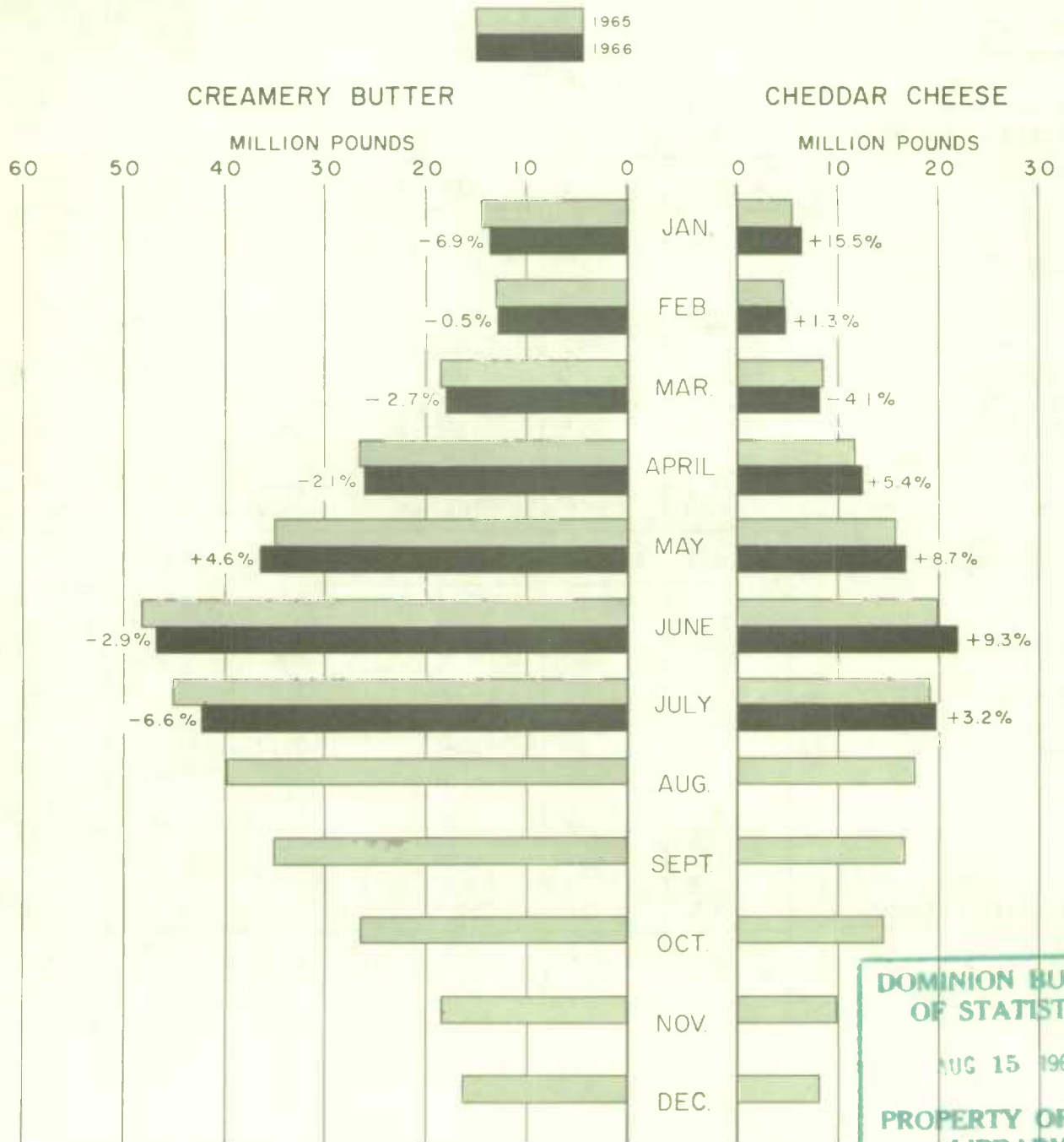

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim powder in Quebec and Ontario during July with the corresponding figure for the last July in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 10,041,000 lb. (10,106,000 lb.); Ontario, 9,682,000 lb. (12,684,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 18,789,000 lb. (15,845,000 lb.); Ontario, 12,379,000 lb. (12,629,000 lb.).
