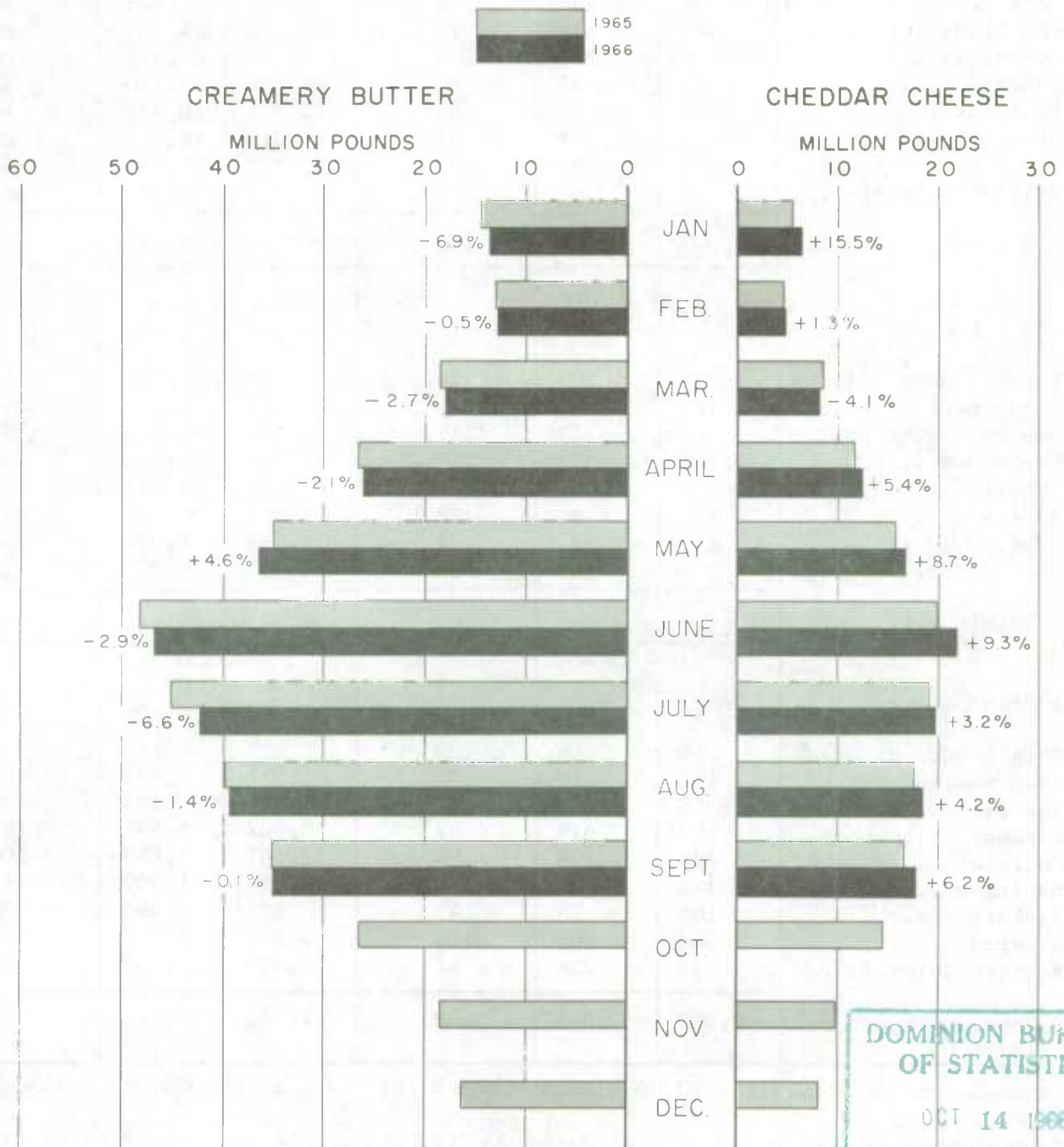

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during September with the corresponding figure for the last September in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 8,515,000 lb. (7,350,000 lb.); Ontario, 10,336,000 lb. (10,747,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 16,975,000 lb. (12,942,000 lb.); Ontario, 10,352,000 lb. (8,896,000 lb.).
