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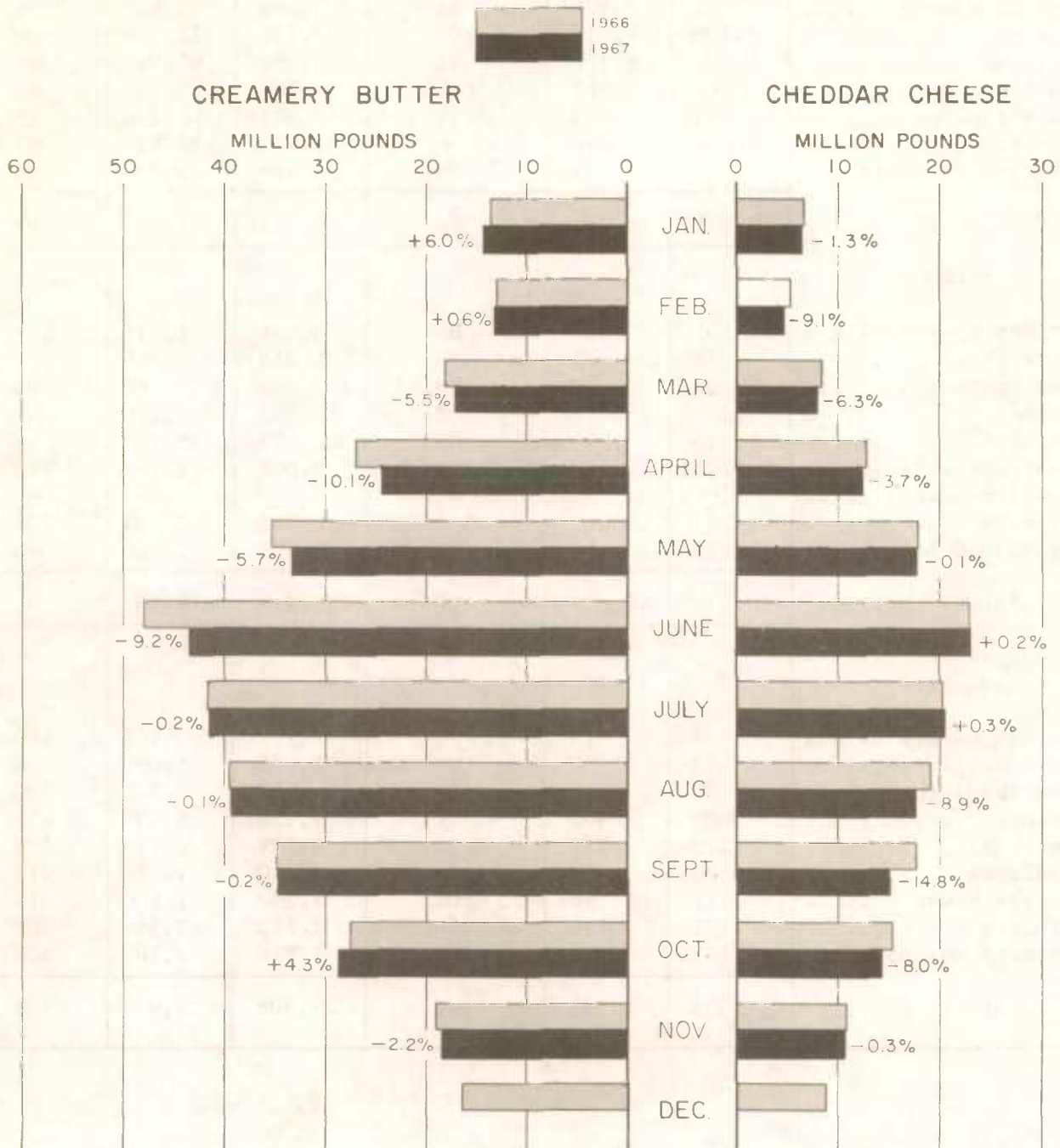

(4,293,000 lb.); Ontario, 5,933,000 lb. (6,481,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 11,730,000 lb. (9,004,000 lb.); Ontario, 4,801,000 lb. (5,253,000 lb.)
