

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during February with the corresponding figure for the last February in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 3,466,000 lb. (2,452,000 lb.); Ontario, 5,969,000 lb. (7,171,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 5,120,000 lb. (3,533,000 lb.); Ontario, 5,568,000 lb. (5,189,000 lb.).
