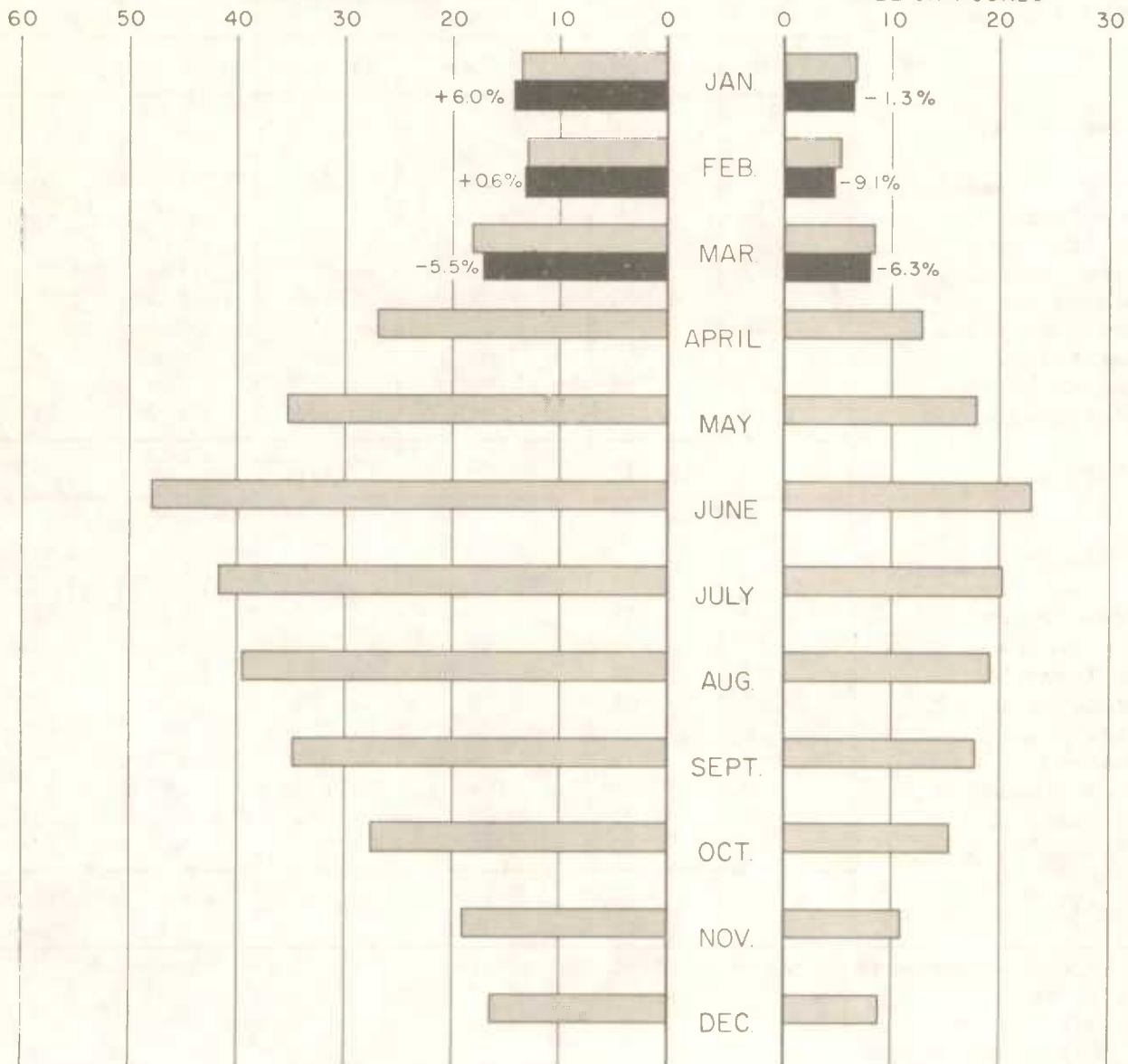

(4,974,000 lb.); Ontario, 8,108,000 lb. (9,996,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 7,490,000 lb. (5,780,000 lb.); Ontario, 7,351,000 lb. (7,030,000 lb.).
