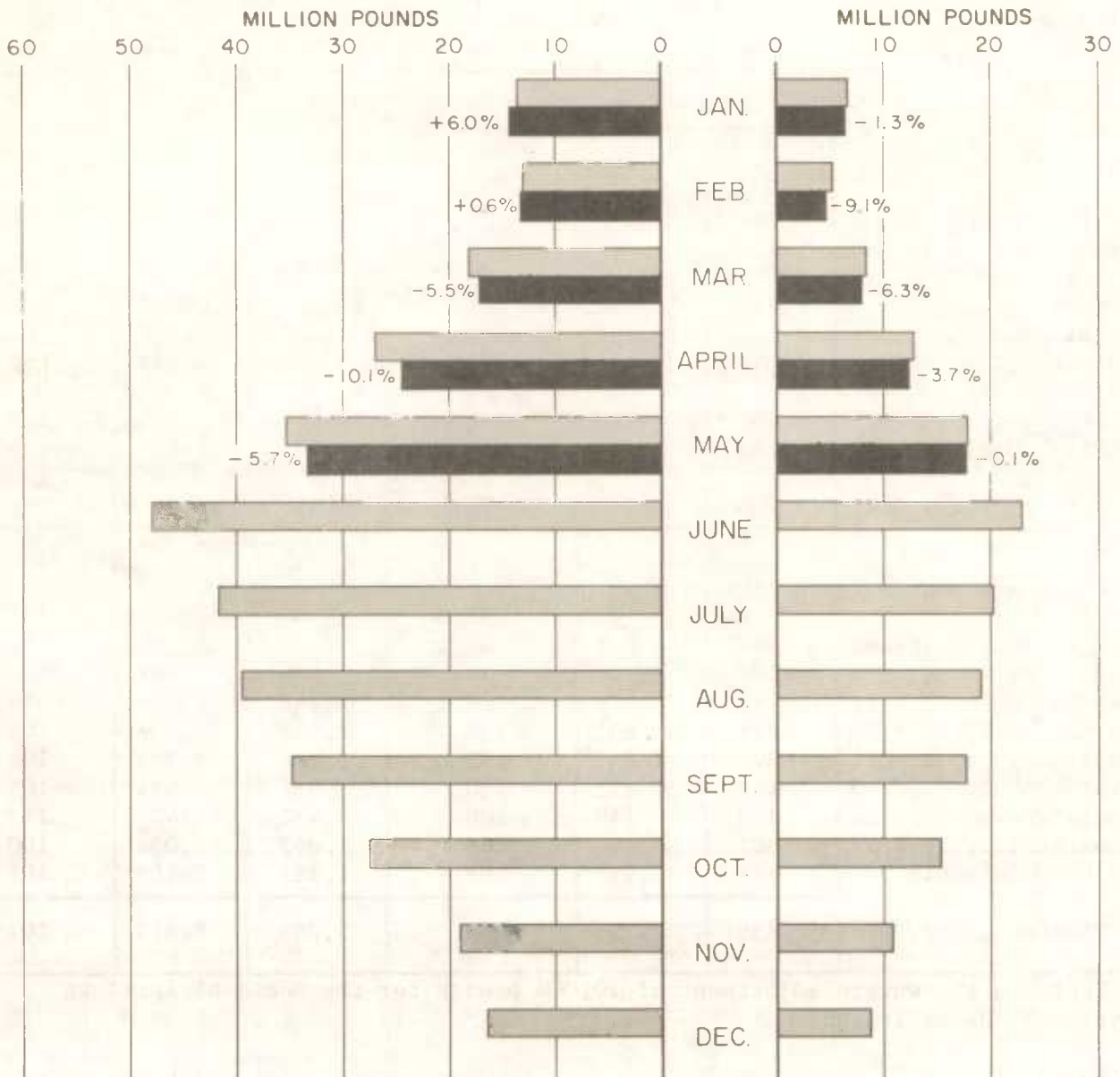

(7,983,000 lb.); Ontario, 11,704,000 lb. (11,617,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 17,810,000 lb. (15,760,000 lb.); Ontario, 11,549,000 lb. (11,817,000 lb.).
