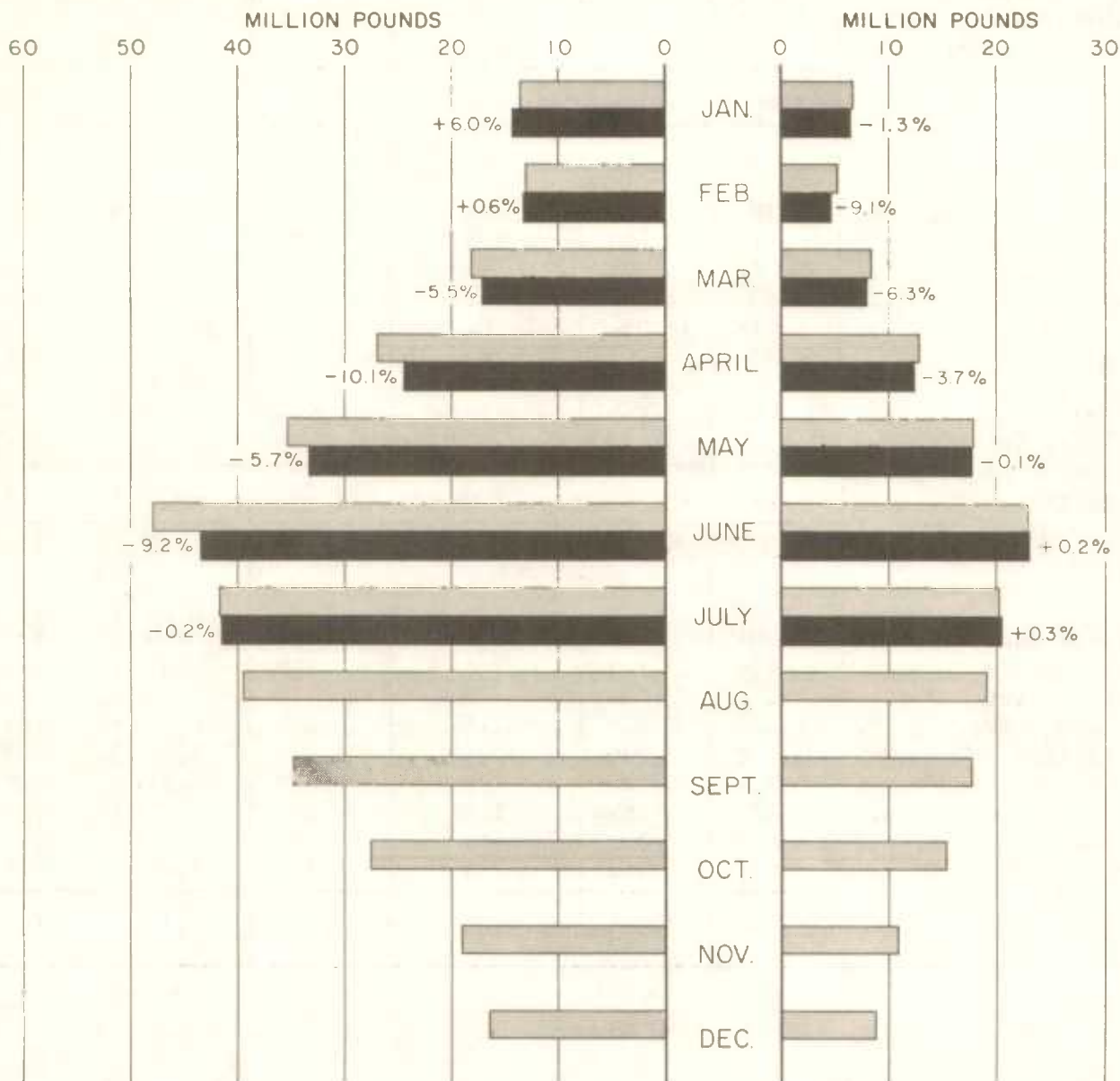

(10,041,000 lb.); Ontario, 10,924,000 lb. (9,682,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 25,869,000 lb. (19,367,000 lb.); Ontario, 12,362,000 lb. (12,213,000 lb.).
