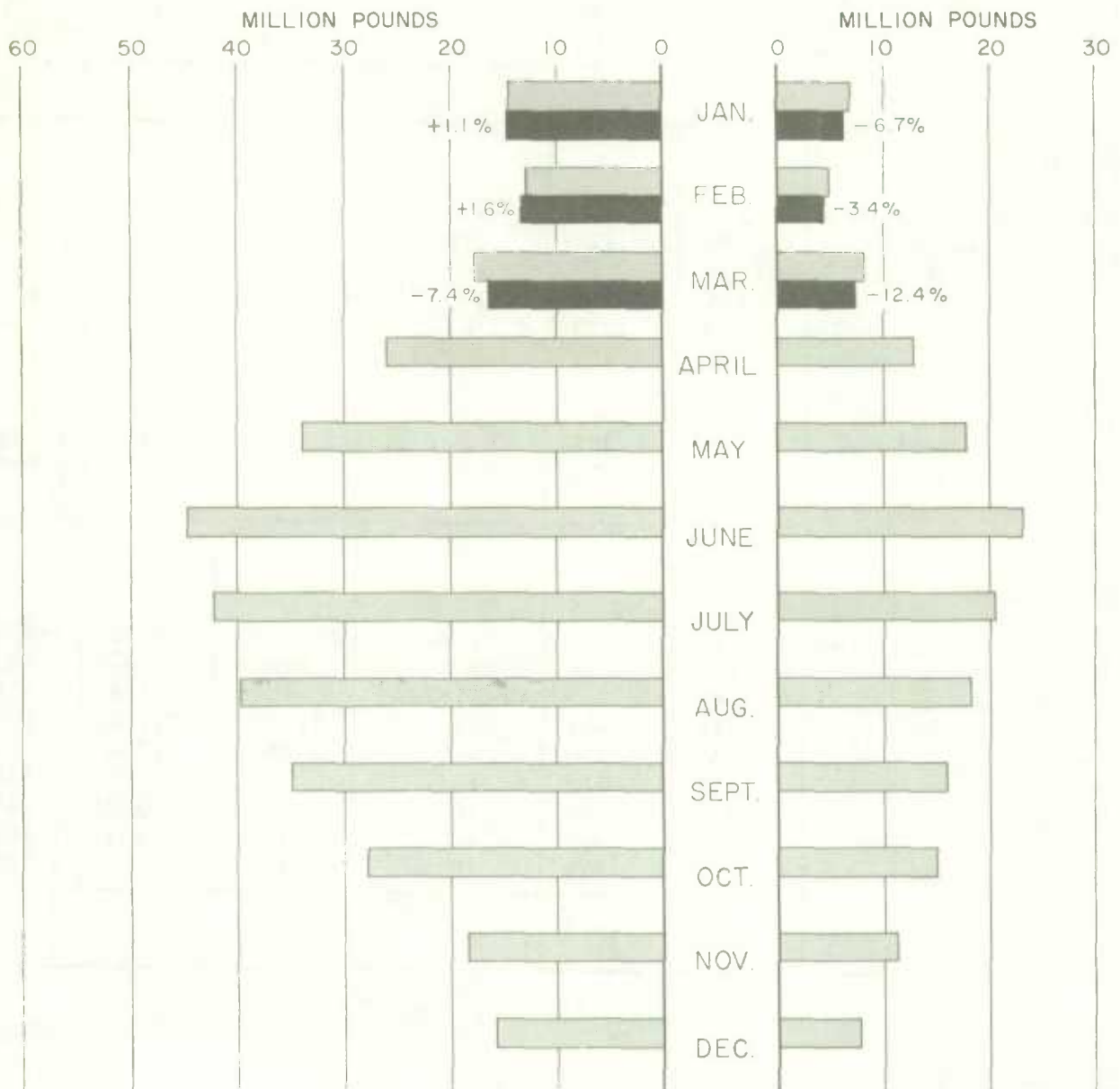

(4,661,000 lb.); Ontario, 7,210,000 lb. (8,108,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 6,573,000 lb. (7,639,000 lb.); Ontario, 6,990,000 lb. (7,276,000 lb.).
