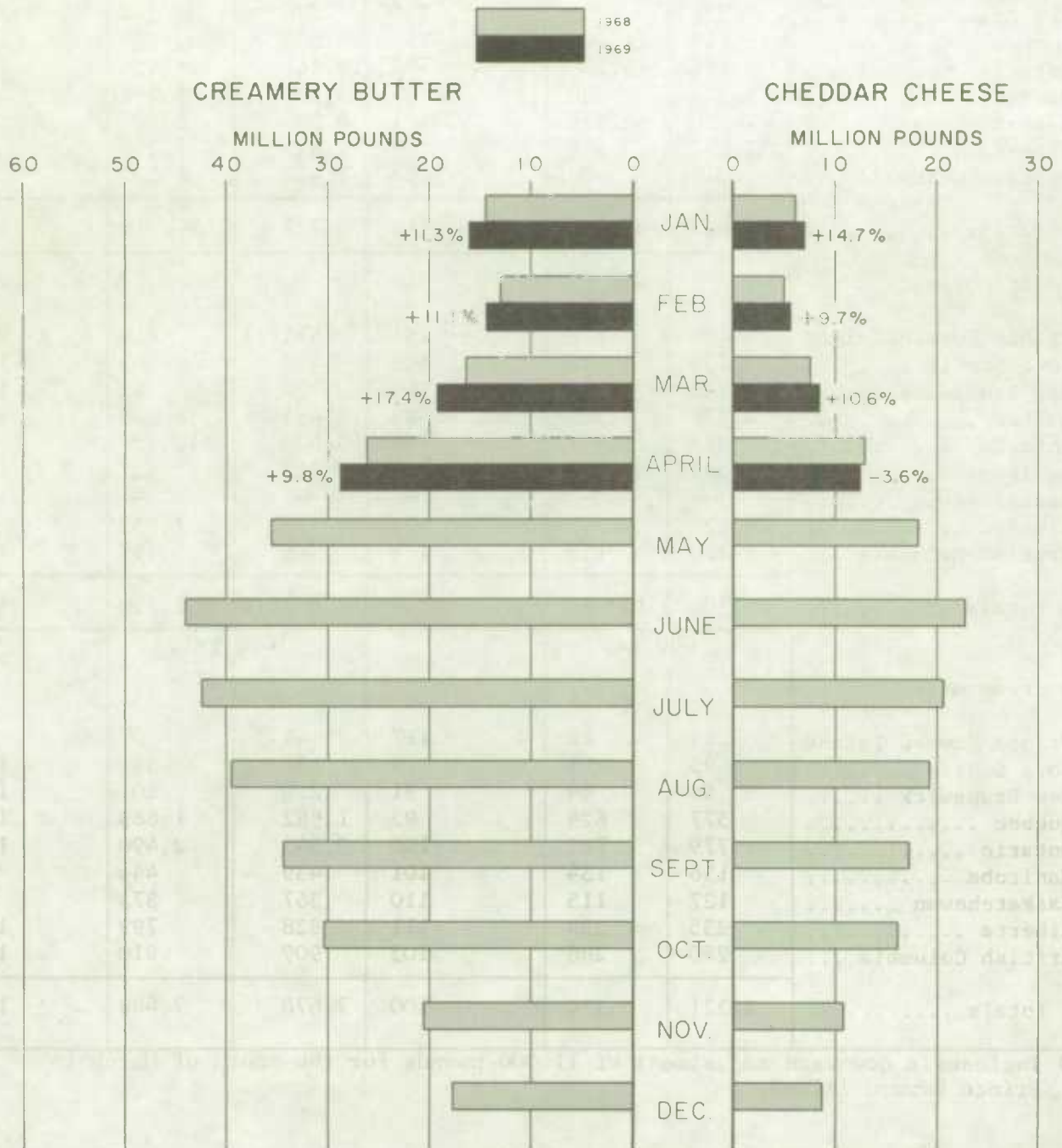

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during April with the corresponding figure for the last April in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 10,408,000 lb. (8,585,000 lb.); Ontario, 6,552,000 lb. (9,087,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 20,261,000 lb. (18,369,000 lb.); Ontario, 9,177,000 lb. (9,166,000 lb.).
