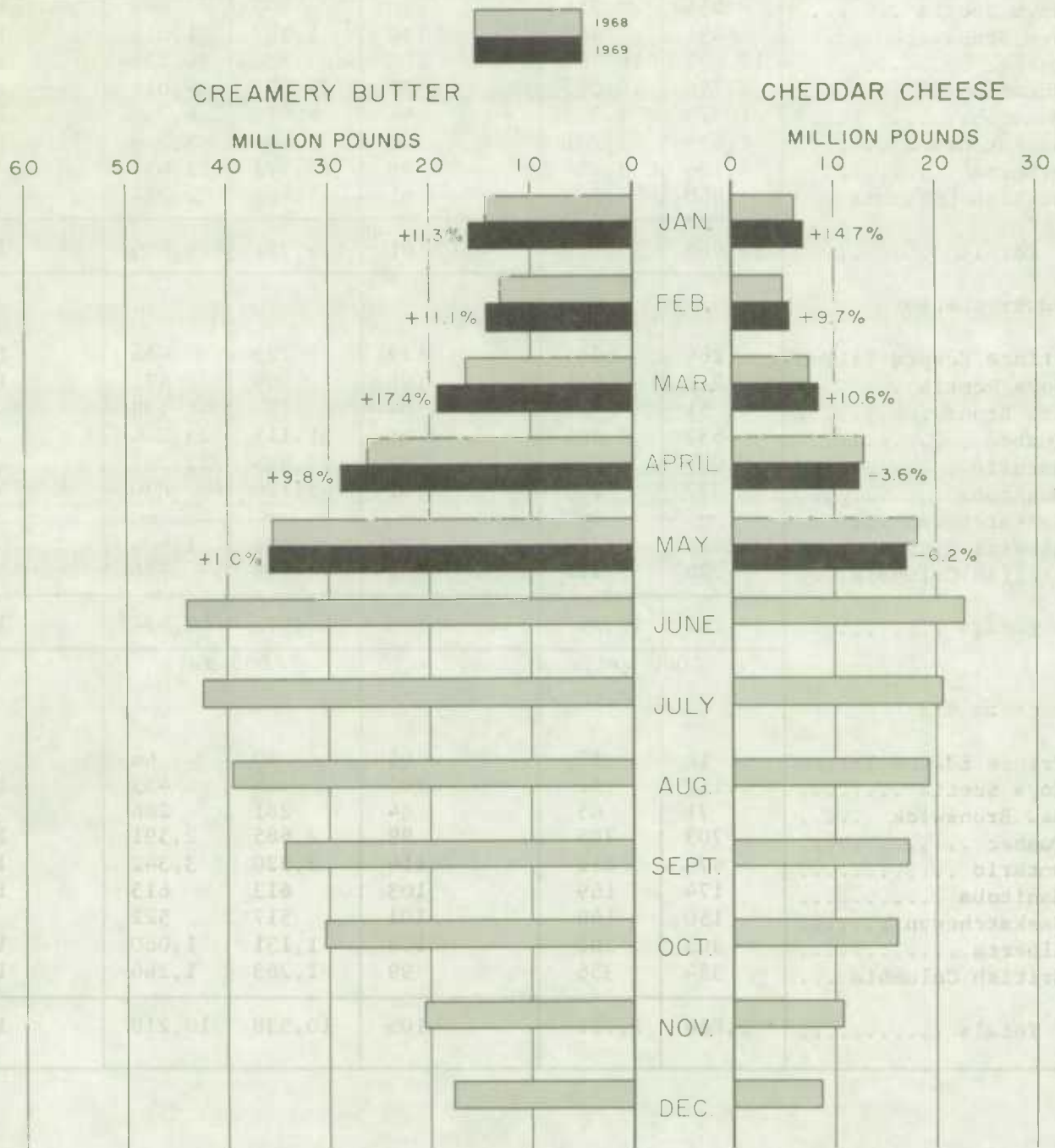

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during May with the corresponding figure for the last May in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 12,693,000 lb. (12,071,000 lb.); Ontario, 7,761,000 lb. (9,883,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 25,069,000 lb. (25,414,000 lb.); Ontario, 11,932,000 lb. (11,633,000 lb.).
