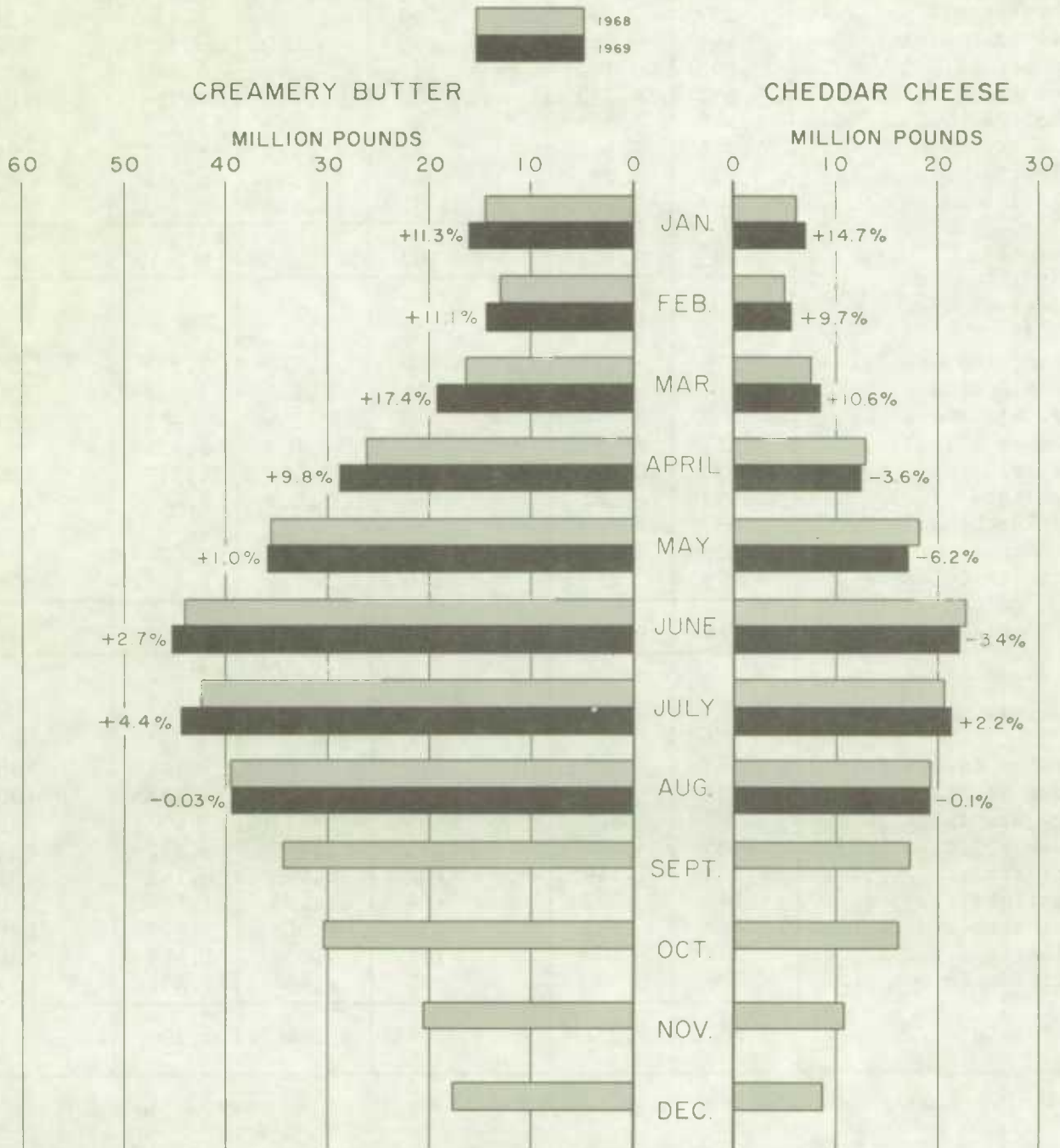

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during August with the corresponding figure for the last August in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 10,732,000 lb. (11,075,000 lb.); Ontario, 6,453,000 lb. (8,752,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 31,724,000 lb. (28,191,000 lb.); Ontario, 12,428,000 lb. (12,697,000 lb.).
