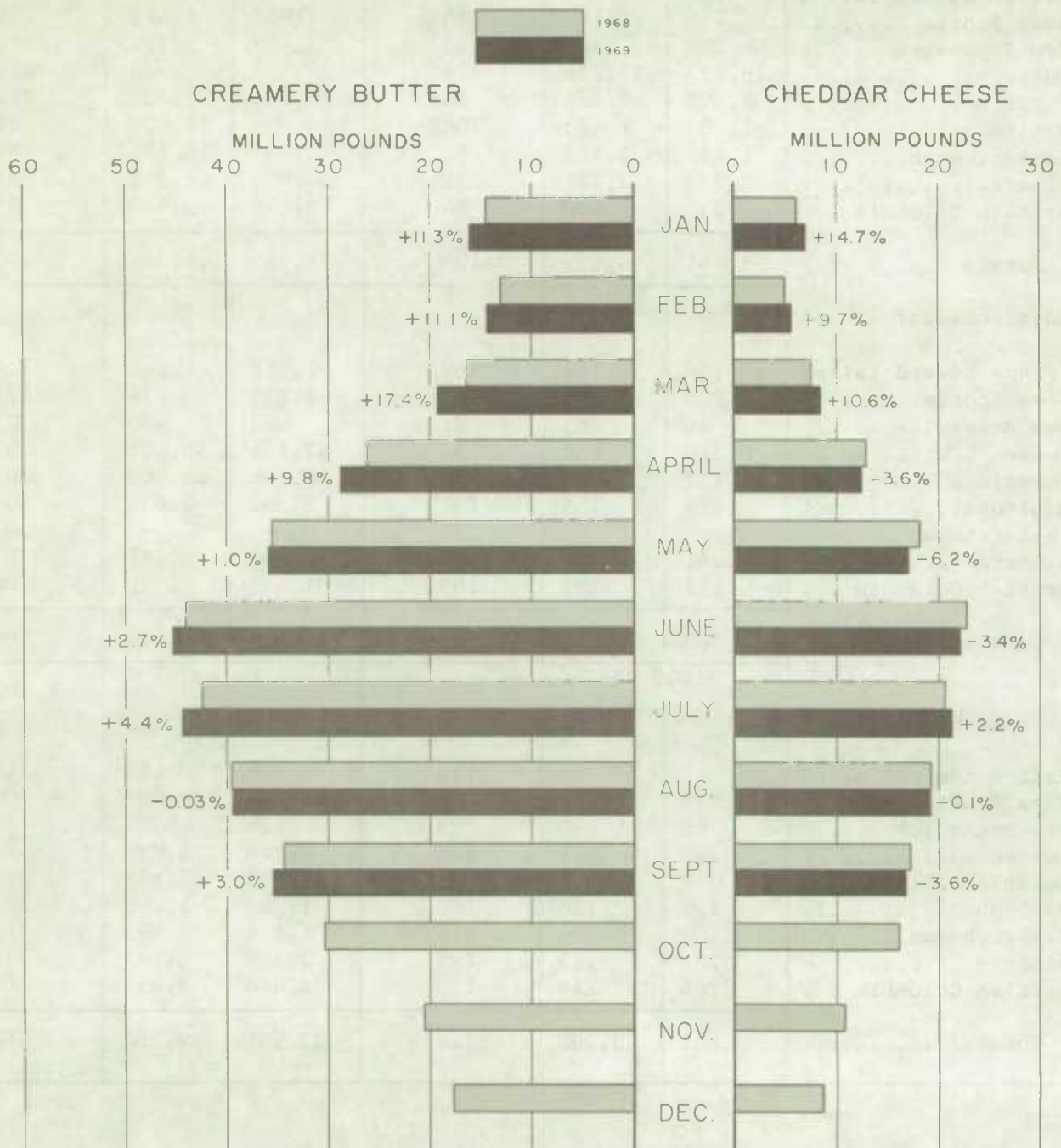

Production of evaporated whole milk and skim milk powder in Quebec and Ontario during September with the corresponding figure for the last September in brackets, was as follows: Evaporated whole milk - Quebec, 10,322,000 lb. (8,369,000 lb.); Ontario, 6,115,000 lb. (7,839,000 lb.); skim milk powder - Quebec, 28,179,000 lb. (23,946,000 lb.); Ontario, 9,791,000 lb. (10,940,000 lb.).
