CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

November, 1933.

Ottawa, Canada, January 5, 1934. - The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products produced for November, 1933, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for November, 1933 amounted to 107,825 barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of November, 1933, 8,158,446 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills as compared with 8,638,600 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. An increase was shown in the grinding of buckwheat, but all other grains were lower than in November, 1932.

Grains ground during the month of November, 1933 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat, 8,158,446 (8,638,600); Oats, 1,262,294 (1,453,153); Corn, 168,662 (209,499); Barley, 81,383 (102,769); Buckwheat, 49,422 (42,307); and Mixed Grain, 1,588,189 (1,941,348).

Mill stocks of wheat on November 30, 1933 amounted to 9,943,671 bushels as compared with 15,300,632 bushels for the corresponding month in 1932.

Flour production in November, 1933 amounted to 1,827,340 barrels compared with 1,942,844 barrels in November, 1932. Exports of flour in November, 1933 amounted to 547,602 barrels compared with 576,864 barrels in the same month of the previous year.

Flour production for the month of November, 1933 amounting to 1,827,340 barrels, compared with 1,942,844 barrels in November, 1932, showed a substantial increase over the previous month, following the tendency of years when November has been the peak month. Bran and shorts were lower than during the corresponding month of the previous year while middlings were higher, with bran 27,769 (28,972) tons, shorts 28,414 (31,078) tons, and middlings 6,833 (6,019) tons. Cereal production for November was as follows with figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeel, 937,171 (1,193,036); Polled Oats, 16,416,025 (17,871,610); Corn Flour and Meal, 2,553,760 (2,466,753); Pot and Pearl Barley, 328,831 (451,146); and Buckwheat Flour, 808,137 (699,552). Emimal feed products were lower than for November, 1932, with ground oats, 9,574,004 (10,295,035) pounds; cracked corn, 4,706,045 (7,308,908) pounds; ground barley, 3,139,547 (3,718,807) pounds; and mixed grain, 70,820,185 (85,906,027) pounds. Total flour stocks for the month of November were 1,308,309 barrels compared with 1,233,565 barrels for the corresponding month of 1932 and 1,154,116 barrels for the previous month.


