CANADIAN NUMBERS STATISTICS September, 1933.

Ottawa, Canada, Hovember 3, 1933. - The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products produced for September, 1933, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for September, 1933 amounted to 111,845 barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of September, 1933.6.179.626 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills as compared with 6.151.677 bushels for the corresponding month last year. A slight increase was shown in grindings of corn but oats, barley, buckwheat and mixed grain were lower than during September, 1932.

Orindings of grains during the month of September, 1933 are shown as follows with comparative figures for the same month last year in brackets; (bushels) Wheat, 6,179,626 (6,151,877); Oats, 900,766 (1,061,749); Corn, 151,413 (147,992); Barley, 62,141 (72,056); Buckwheat, 20,800 (25,668); Mixed Grain, 1,127,286 (1,174,201).

Will stocks of wheat on September 30, 1933 amounted to 9,989,401 bushels as compared with 8,370,164 bushels for September of last year.

Flour production in September, 1933 amounted to 1,392,683 barrels compared with 1,384,500 barrels in the same month last year. Exports of flour during September, 1933 amounted to 552,556 barrels compared with 385,113 barrels for the same month last year.

Mour production for the month of September, 1933, amounting to 1,392.683 barrels, fell below the amount produced in August but was slightly higher than September of last year when 1,384,500 barrels were produced. Bran, shorts and middlings were in line with flour production showing a slight increase in the aggregate over the same month last year, with bran 20,750 (18,661) tons, shorts 22,290 (22,514) tons, middlings 5,258 (5,212) tons. Cereal production for September was as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and quantities in pounds: Catmeal, 598.044 (777,966); Rolled Cats, 12,093,243 (14,124,180); Corn Mour and Meal, 2,499,304 (2,226,154); Pot and Pearl Barley, 229,744 (329,123); Buckwheat Mour, 344,094 (473,548). Animal feed products were lower than for September of last year with ground cats, 6,006,401 (6,461,213) pounds; cracked corn, 3,732,492 (4,107,537) pounds; ground barley, 2,374,095 (2,528,838) pounds; and mixed grain, 50,368,632 (52,496,935) pounds. Total flour stocks for the month were 1,006,571 barrels compared with 953,549 barrels for the corresponding month last year and 1,004,944 barrels for the previous month.
