Ottawa, Canada, December 7, 1934.— The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for October, 1934, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for October, 1934 amounted to 95,766 barrels.

SUM ARY

During the month of October, 1934, 7,426,566 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 7,345,792 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. Oats and barley were higher than for October, 1933 with corn, buckwheat and mixed grain slightly lower.

Grains ground for the month of October, 1934 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat 7,426,506 (7,345,792); Oats 1,260,471 (1,153,701); Corn 152,965 (153,862); Barley 75,673 (74,011); Buckwheat 42,114 (57,750); and Mixed Grain 1,330,138 (1,353,384).

Mill stocks of wheat on October 31, 1934 amounted to 11,157,102 bushels, while for the same month in 1933 the amount was 9,771,679 bushels.

Flour production in October, 1934 amounted to 1,654,189 barrels compared with 1,650,557 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in October, 1934 amounted to 485,549 barrels compared with 514,368 barrels in October, 1933.

Flour production for the month of October, 1934 amounted to 1,654,189 barrels. The quantity manufactured in the same month last year was 1,650,557 barrels. The total output of wheat offal increased accordingly with bran 25,374 (24,777) tons, shorts 25,632 (26,325) tons, and middlings 6,576 (5,800) tons.

Cereal production for October, 1934 was as follows with the figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 1,065,990 (751,566); Rolled Oats, 16,697,250 (15,676,287); Corn Flour and Meal, 1,725,600 (2,153,041); Pot and Pearl Barley, 282,420 (371,841); and Buckwheat Flour, 694,011 (961,280).

Animal feed products compared as follows: Ground Oats, 7,642,898 (7,514,128) pounds; Cracked Corn, 4,269,639 (4,203,955) pounds; Ground Barley, 3,047,473 (2,645,988) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 59,213,397 (60,315,362) pounds.

Total flour stocks for the month of October amounted to 1,039,622 barrels compared with 1,154,116 barrels for the same month last year and 1,066,518 barrels for the previous month.


