CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

February, 1934.

Ottawa, Canada, April 6, 1934. The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products produced for February, 1934, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for February, 1934 amounted to 99,157 barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of February, 1934, 4,887.102 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 3,744,957 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. Grindings of cats, corn, barley and mixed grain were higher than in February, 1933, while buckwheat showed a decrease.

Grains ground during the month of February, 1934, are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat, 4,887,102 (3,744,957); Oats, 786,180 (698,881); Corn, 157,303 (125,805); Barley, 99,837 (55,880); Buckwheat, 7,169 (11,529); and Mixed Grain, 1,379,894 (1,275,855).

Mill stocks of wheat on February 28, 1934 amounted to 8,722,856 bushels while for the same month in 1933 the amount was 8,811,463 bushels.

Flour production in February, 1934 amounted to 1,102,043 barrels compared with 844,899 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in February, 1934 amounted to 328,376 barrels, slightly lower than for the same month in 1933 when 333,114 barrels were exported.

Flour production for the month of February, 1934 amounting to 1,102.043 barrels showed a substantial increase over the same month in 1933 when 844,899 barrels were produced and was higher than for the previous month. Bran, shorts and middlings, following the flour trend, were higher than for the corresponding month last year, with bran 15,967 (13,427) tons, shorts 17,521 (12,516) tons, and middlings 3,642 (2,527) tons. Cereal production for February, 1934 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds; Oatmeal, 558,853 (527,576); Rolled Oats, 9,338,950 (7,613,556); Corn Flour and Meal, 2,680,727 (1,951,278); Pot and Pearl Barley, 363,530 (251,615); and Buckwheat Flour, 116,201 (184,520). Animal feed products were higher than for February, 1933 with ground oats, 7,466,033 (6,697,338) pounds; cracked corn, 3,640,436 (3,405,917) pounds; ground barley, 3,692,808 (1,993,870) pounds; and mixed grain, 61,468,342 (57,031,661) pounds. Total flour stocks for the month of February, 1934 were 1,181,688 barrels compared with 1,114,300 barrels for the same month a year ago and 1,157,265 barrels for the previous month.
