## CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

## March, 1934.

Ottawa, Canada, May 4, 1934.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for March, 1934, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for March, 1934 amounted to 99,515 barrels.

#### SULMARY

During the month of March, 1934, 4,740,844 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 4,451,773 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. Grindings of oats, corn, buckwheat and mixed grain were lower than in March, 1933, while barley showed an increase.

Grains ground during the month of March, 1934, are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat, 4,740,844 (4,451,773); Osts, 694,721 (799,911); Corn, 156,800 (174,940); Barley, 80,562 (60,804); Buckwheat, 8,819 (9,441); and Mixed Grain, 1,154,072 (1,545,154).

Mill stocks of wheat on March 31, 1934 amounted to 6,900,223 bushels while for the same month in 1933 the amount was 8,257,533 bushels.

Flour production in March, 1934 amounted to 1,064,428 barrels compared with 1,004,787 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in March, 1934 amounted to 493,327 barrels, showing a slight increase over the same month in 1933 when 490,270 barrels were exported.

#### MILL GRINDINGS

The following table shows the amount of wheat, cats, corn, barley, buckwheat and mixed grain milled for the month of March, 1934, by merchant and custom mills in Canada according to divisions, with comparative totals for the same month last year and stocks on hand at March 31, 1934 (in bushels):-

Flour production for the month of March, 1934 amounted to 1,064,428 barrels, which was slightly higher than for the same month in 1933 when 1,004,787 barrels were produced. The production for the current month was lower than in February, following the usual trend of the industry at this season. Compared with the same month last year bran, shorts and middlings were higher, with bran 16,228 (15,721) tons, shorts 16,283 (15,808) tons, and middlings 3,464 (2,157) tons. Cereal production for March, 1934 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 569,533 (559,858); Rolled Oats, 7,866,835 (8,588,777); Corn Flour and Meal, 2,243,390 (2,916,344); Pot and Pearl Barley, 141,738 (332,808); and Buckwheat Flour, 145,142 (156,104). With the exception of ground Datley, animal feed products were lower than for March, 1933. The quantities were as follows: Ground Oats, 7,581,358 (8,495,827) pounds; Cracked Corn, 3,451,015 (4,146,372) pounds; Ground Barley, 3,547,466 (2,111,251) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 51,461,462 (69,137,398) pounds. Total flour stocks for the month of March, 1934 were 1,058,323 barrels compared with 998,894 barrels for the same month last year and 1,181,688 barrels for the previous month.
