CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS MAY, 1934.

Ottawa, Canada, July 6, 1934. The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for May, 1934, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for May, 1934 amounted to 96,730 barrals.

SUMMARY

During the month of May, 1934, 5,258,707 bishels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 5,959,063 busiels for the corresponding month of the previous year. With the exception of buckwheat, other grains were lower than for May, 1933.

Grains ground for the month of May, 1934 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in bankets: Wheat 5,258,707 (5,959,063); Oats, 578,306 (621,591); Corn, 144,344 (194,404); Barley 47,978 (49,211) Buckwheat, 3,808 (2,744); and Mixed Grain, 726,298 (1,021,874).

Mill stocks of wheat on May 31, 1934 amounted to 8,496,091 bushels, while for the same month in 1933 the amount was 8,136,998 bushels.

Flour production in May, 1934 emounted to 1,175,433 barrels compared with 1,334,101 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in May, 1934 amounted to 481,725 barrels compared with 565,080 barrels in May, 1933.

Flour production for the month of May, 1934 amounted to 1,175,433 barrels, exceeding the amount for the previous month, but lower than for the same month in 1933 when 1,334,101 barrels were produced. The total wheat offal is lower than for the corresponding month last year, with bran 21,291 (21,144) tons, shorts 14,698 (20,147) tons, and middlings 4,009 (4,078) tons. Cereal production for May, 1934 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 614,693 (556,907); Rolled Oats, 6,132,154 (6,464,036); Corn Flour and Meal, 2,567,066 (3,510,758); Pot and Pearl Barley, 104,860 (191,100); and Buckwheat Flour 62,869 (43,904). The quantities of animal feed products were as follows: Ground Oats, 6,265,372 (6,230,374) pounds; Cracked Corn, 2,749,953 (4,214,329) pounds; Ground Barley, 2,107,189 (1,874,680) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 32,339,454 (45,609,865) pounds. Total flour stocks for the month of May, 1934 were 1,017,980 barrels compared with 926,314 barrels for the same month last year and 957,321 barrels for the previous month.
