CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

November, 1935

Ottawa, Canada, Jamuary 3, 1936.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for November, 1935, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for November, 1935 amounted to 95,138 barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of November, 1935, 7,262,558 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 7,659,806 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. Coarse grains with the exception of buckwheat, were higher than for November, 1934.

Grains ground for the month of November, 1935 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat 7,262,558 (7,659,805); Oats 1,513,259 (1,162,272); Corn 166,813 (149,553); Barley 128,150 (60,079); Buckwheat 29,413 (34,171); and Fixed Grains 1,778,718 (1,473,878).

Mill Stocks of wheat on November 30, 1935 amounted to 12,491,739 bushels, while for the same month in 1934 the amount was 11,881,518 bushels.

Flour production in November, 1935 amounted to 1,603,803 barrels compared with 1,703,831 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in November, 1935 amounted to 525,368 barrels compared with 504,384 barrels in November, 1934.

Flour production for the month of November, 1935 amounted to 1,603,803 barrels compared with 1,703,831 barrels in the same month of 1934. November production of flour showed a decline from the previous month. Wheat offal output declined accordingly with bran 26,125 (26,025) tons, shorts 25,835 (26,170) tons, and middlings 6,749 (6,908) tons.

Cereal production for the month of November, 1935 was as follows with the figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 1,549,038 (1,119,776); Rolled Oats, 17,448,402 (14,345,997); Corn Flour and Meal, 1,944,746 (1,570,810); Pot and Pearl Barley, 363,638 (247,165); and Buckwheat Flour, 529,644 (560,772).

Animal feed products increased over last year and compared as follows: Ground Oats, 9,896,778 (8,084,432) pounds; Cracked Corn, 5,571,943 (4,286,595) pounds; Ground Barley, 4,535,626 (2,903,761) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 79,374,452 (65,854,153) pounds.

Total flour stocks for the month of November amounted to 1,200,160 barrels compared with 1,303,360 barrels for the same month last year and 1,112,334 barrels for the previous month.


