

# October, 1936.

Ottawa, Canada, December 3, 1936. - The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for October, 1936, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The duily capacity reporting for October, 1936 amounted to 94,653 barrels.

#### SUMMARY

Ouring the menth of October, 1936, 7,681,108 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 8,261,087 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. Corn, barley and buckwheat were in the for October, 1935, while oats and mixed grain were much lower.

Orains ground for the month of October, 1936 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same menth of the previous year in brackets: Wheat 7,681,108 (8,261,087); Octs 1,334,687 (1,543,665); Corn 206,503 (218,229); Barley 129,864 (99,278); Buckwheat 32,313 (30,417); and Mixed Grain 1,597,656 (1,627,948).

Eill stocks of wheat on October 31, 1936 amounted to 9,502,743 bushels, while for the same menth in 1939 the amount was 11,525,038 bushels.

Flour production in October, 1936 amounted to 1,701,267 barrels compared with 1,824,754 barrels for the same ments lent year. exports of flour in October 1936 amounted to 464,013 barrels compared with 501,442 barrels is October, 1935.

Flour output for the month of October, 1936 amounted to 1,701,267 barrels, an increase of 185,144 barrels over the previous month. Production was much lower than for the same month in 1935 when 1,824,754 barrels were manufactured. Theat offal declined in the aggregate, with bran 25,033 (28,616) tons, shorts 29,714 (29,862) tons and middlings 8,487 (7,317) tons.

Cereal production for the month of October, 1936 was as follows with the figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 828,039 (1,700,720); Rolled Oats, 15,644,707 (19,488,481); Corn Flour and Meal, 2,641,308 (2,842,570); Pot and Pearl Barley, 389,492 (389,092); and Suckwheat Flour, 548,058 (561,549).

Animal feed products compared as follows: Ground Oats, 10,402,164 (8,485,108); Cracked Corn, 9,780,749 (6,345,301); Ground Barley, 4,889,473 (3,413,886); and Eixed Grain, 71,105,044 (72,391,987) pounds.

Total flour stocks in October, 1936 amounted to 1,133,032 berrels compared with 1,112,334 barrels for the same month last year and 1,088,030 barrels for the previous month.


