### CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

#### February, 1936.

Ottawa, Canada, April 3, 1936.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains gound and products for February, 1936, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for February, 1936 amounted to 94,278 barrels.

#### SUMMARY

During the month of February, 1936, 4,614,569 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 4,220,917 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. In the coarse grain group, buckwheat and mixed grain were lower than for February, 1935.

Grains ground for the month of February, 1936 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat 4,614,569 (4,220,917); Oats 933,981 (774,621); Corn 214,960 (172,875); Barley 87,505 (74,196); Buckwheat 7,186 (8,060); and Mixed Grain 1,668,912 (1,937,664).

Mill Stocks of wheat on February 29, 1936 amounted to 10,322,862 bushels, while for the same month in 1955 the amount was 10,249,333 bushels.

Flour production in February, 1936 amounted to 1,019,017 barrels compared with 941,417 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in February, 1936 amounted to 340,102 barrels compared with 309,729 barrels in February, 1935.

Flour production for the month of February, 1936 amounted to 1,019,017 barrels compared with 941,417 barrels for the same month last year. This was an increase over the previous month's grind and the same trend was reflected in the exports. Whaat offal increased, with bran 16,828 (14,490) tons, shorts 15,499 (14,383) tons and middlings 4,481 (3,823) tons.

Cereal production for February, 1936 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 495,282 (636,312); Rolled Oats, 10,642,544 (8,739,753); Corn Flour and Meal, 1,607,494 (1,491,528); Pot and Pearl Barley, 266,167 (272,758); and Buckwheat Flour, 134,029 (131,586).

Animal feed products were higher than for the previous year and compared as follows: Ground Oats, 7,621,538 (7,457,083) pounds; Cracked Corn, 7,223,395 (5,023,794) pounds; Ground Barley, 3,391,394 (2,909,200) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 74,671,357 (73,501,956) pounds.

Total flour stocks for the month of February, 1936 amounted to 1,066,783 barrels compared with 1,259,177 barrels for the same month last year and 1,070,249 barrels for the previous month.




