

CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

May, 1936.

Ottawa, Canada, July 2, 1936. The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for May, 1936, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for May, 1936 amounted to 94,796 barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of May, 1936, 5,473,533 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 5,188,296 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. Oats, corn, buckwheat and mixed grain were lower than for May, 1935, while barley was higher.

Grains ground for the month of May, 1936 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat 5,473,533 (5.188,296); Oats, 692,602 (699,498); Corn, 220,384 (241,095); Barley, 79,021 (44.710); Buckwheat 1,660 (3,210); and Mixed Grain, 1,026,021 (1,066,167).

Mill stocks of wheat on May 31, 1936 amounted to 9,969,933 bushels, while for the same month in 1936 the amount was 8,532,267 bushels.

Flour production in May, 1936 amounted to 1,196,339 barrels compared with 1,164,322 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in May, 1936 amounted to 448,653 barrels compared with 383,221 barrels in May, 1935.

MILL GRINDINGS

The following table shows the amount of wheat, cats, corn, barley, buckwheat and mixed grain milled for the month of May, 1936, by merchant and custom mills in Canada according to divisions, with comparative totals for the same month last year and stocks on hand at May 31, 1936, (in bushels):-

Flour production for the month of May, 1936, amounted to 1,196,339 barrels and was the largest since Movember. The comparative figure for the same month last year was 1,164,322 barrels. Following the flour trend, wheat offal was higher than for the corresponding month with bran 19,304 (18,786) tons, shorts 20,092 (16,668) tons and middlings 5,642 (3,882) tons.

Cereal production for May, 1936 was as follows with figures for the name month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Catmeal, 433,634 (816,112); Rolled Oats, 8,451,646 (7,538,950); Corn Flour and Meal, 1,845,144 (2,013,518); Pot and Fearl Barley, 87,283 (166,080); and Buckwheat Flour, 26,560 (52,016).

Animal feed products compared as follows: Ground Oats, 5,683,261 (6,220,772) pounds; Cracked Corn, 5,937,282 (6,052,346) pounds, Ground Barley. 3,034,726 (1,835,638) pounds, and Mixed Grain, 45,756,087 (47,739,113) pounds.

Total flour stocks for the month of May, 1936 amounted to 1,093,376 barrels compared with 1,158,281 barrels for the same month last year and 1,081,872 barrels for the previous month.


