CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS September, 1936.

Ottawa, Canada, November 5, 1936. The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for September, 1936, with comparison for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for September, 1936 amounted to 94,526 barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of September, 1936, 6,866,806 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 6,932,568 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. Corn, barley and mixed grain were higher than for September, 1935, while oats and buckwheat were slightly lower.

Grains ground for the month of September, 1936 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat, 6,866,806 (6,932,568); Oats, 1,107,886 (1,151,068); Corn, 273,700 (218,914); Barley, 104,696 (68,880); Buckwheat, 9,751 (10,373); and Mixed Grain, 1,269,421 (1,134,815).

Mill stocks of wheat on September 30, 1936 amounted to 10,328,188 bushels, while for the same month in 1935 the amount was 10,680,087 bushels.

Flour production in September, 1936 amounted to 1,516,123 barrels compared with 1,535,189 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in September, 1936 amounted to 378,318 barrels compared with 395,640 barrels in September, 1935.

Flour production for the month of September, 1936 amounted to 1,516,123 barrels compared with 1.535.189 barrels for the same month lest year.

Mill feeds were slightly irregular in comparison with the flour trend showing a higher aggregate than for September, 1935, with bran 22,596 (23,315)tons, shorts 26,045 (24,579) tons, and middlings 7,933 (6,369) tons-

Cereal production for September, 1936 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in Descripts and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 669,032(902,388); Rolled Oats, 13,431,935 (13,911,445); Corn Flour and Meal, 3,100,740 (2,312,180); Pot and Peerl Barley, 265,560 (276,110); and Buckwheat Flour, 187,308 (171,000)

Animal feed products compared as follows: Ground Oats, 8,187,822 (6,266,185) pounds; Cracked Corn, 7,044,298 (6,352,538) pounds; Ground Barley, 4,425,785 (2,402,947) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 56,794,154 (50,663,550) pounds.

Total flour stocks for the month of September, 1936 amounted to 1,088,030 barrels compared with 982,721 barrels for the same month last year and 1,025,914 barrels for the gravious month.


