CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS January, 1937.

Ottawa, Canada, March 4, 1937.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains gound and products for January, 1937, with comparison for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for January, 1937 amounted to 95,785 barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of January, 1937, 4,559,838 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 4,460,277 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. Barley and mixed grain were lower than for January, 1936, while oats, corn and buckwheat were higher.

Grains ground for the month of January, 1937 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat 4,559,838 (4,460,277); Oats 1,038,842 (924,352); Corn 232,776 (175,800); Barley 87,463 (104,313): Buckwheat 11,720 (7,555); and Mixed Grain 1,399,984 (1,837,890).

Mill stocks of wheat on January 31, 1937 amounted to 9,145,309 bushels, while for the same month in 1936 the amount was 11,895,175 bushels.

Flour production in January, 1937 amounted to 1,008,630 barrels compared with 951,985 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in January, 1937 amounted to 313,923 barrels compared with 314,311 barrels in January, 1936.

MILL GRINDINGS

Flour production for the month of January, 1937 was slightly higher than for the same month of the previous year, amounting to 1,008,630 barrels compared with 981,983 barrels. Wheat offal was higher too, with bran 16,693 (15,881) tons, shorts 15,510 (15,011) tons, and middlings 4,799 (3,945) tons.

Cereal production for January, 1937 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 1,026,104 (652,865); Rolled Oats, 11,271,533 (9,098,636); Corn Flour and Meal, 1,620,204 (1,772,118); Pot and Pearl Barley, 251,218 (265,697); and Buckwheat Flour, 220,415 (122,070).

Animal feed products compared as follows: Ground Oats, 10,498,205 (9,337,122) pounds; Cracked Corn, 9,591,240 (5,743,572) pounds; Ground Barley, 3,472,470 (4,306,612) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 62,133,643 (81,966,343) pounds.

Total flour stocks for the month of January, 1937 amounted to 1,091,723 barrels compared with 1,070,249 barrels for the same month in 1936 and 1,149,957 barrels for the previous month.


