CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

April. 1937.

Ottawa, Canada, June 3, 1937.- The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for April, 1937, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for April, 1937 amounted to 95,692 barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of April, 1937, 4,750,994 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 4,582,442 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. In the coarse grain group, cats and corn were higher than for April, 1936, while barley, buckwheat and mixed grain were lower.

Grains ground for the month of April, 1937 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat 4,750,994 (4,582,442); Oats, 822,207 (694,603); Corn, 313,495 (248,909); Barley 68,408 (84,408); Buckwheat 5,574 (8,236); and Mixed Grain, 1,112,439 (1,625,671).

Mill stocks of wheat on April 30, 1937 amounted to 6,029,642 bushels, while for the same month in 1936 the amount was 8,352,836 bushels.

Flour production in April, 1937 amounted to 1,051,564 barrels compared with 1,009,464 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in April, 1937 amounted to 285,724 barrels compared with 281,162 barrels in April 1936.

Flour production for the month of April, 1937 amounted to 1,051,564 barrels compared with 1,009,464 barrels for the same month last year. Total wheat offal figures were higher with bran 16,986 (16,411) tons, shorts 17,005 (16,008) tons and middlings 4,236 (4,595) tons.

Cereal production for April, 1937 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 580,435 (449,317); Rolled Oats, 8,354,544 (7,186,522); Corn Flour and Meal, 1,923,176 (2,119,274); Pot and Pearl Barley, 213,504 (193,633); and Buckwheat Flour, 90,528 (134,634).

Animal feed products compared as follows: Ground Oats, 9,198,532 (8,014,135) pounds; Cracked Corn, 10,325,936 (7,005,862) pounds; Ground Barley, 2,786,795 (3,244,720) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 49,704,291 (72,882,796) pounds.

Total flour stocks for the month of April, 1937 amounted to 1,132,746 barrels compared with 1,081,872 barrels for the same month last year and 1,127,949 barrels for the previous month.
