CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

July, 1937.

Ottawa, Canada, September 2, 1937. - The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for July, 1937, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for July, 1937 amounted to 94,918 barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of July, 1937, 4,926,832 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 5,939,551 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. Oats, corn, barley and mixed grain were lower than for July, 1936, while buckwheat was higher.

Grains ground for the month of July, 1937 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat 4,926,832 (5,939,551); Oats 710,712 (1,034,395); Corn 249,566 (288,918); Barley, 70,751 (80,837); Buckwheat, 3,309 (2,907); and Mixed Grain 552,667 (869,634).

Mill stocks of wheat on July, 31, 1937 amounted to 5,390,606 bushels, while for the same month in 1936 the amount was 7,030,561 bushels.

Flour production in July, 1937 amounted to 1,087,159 barrels compared with 1,300,667 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in July, 1937 amounted to 334,964 barrels compared with 444,905 barrels in July, 1936.

Flour production for the month of July, 1937 amounted to 1,087,159 barrels compared with 1,300,667 barrels for the same month last year, making a total of 14,276,607 barrels for the crop year 1936-37 compared with 14,910,380 barrels for the crop year 1935-36. Wheat offal for the month of July was lower than for the previous year with bran 15,598 (20,298) tons, shorts 19,153 (22,577) tons and middlings 5,563 (6,659) tons.

Cereal production for July, 1937 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 263,314 (421,204); Rolled Oats, 8,673,332 (11,614,639); Corn Flour and Meel, 2,244,240 (2,037,400); Pot and Pearl Barley, 64,876 (95,070); and Buckwheat Flour, 54,180 (47,396).

In the animal feed group, ground barley was slightly higher than for the previous year but the other three showed considerable decline. The quantities were as follows: Ground Cats, 5,778,057 (7,324,594) pounds; Cracked Corn, 7,738,017 (8,641,187) pounds; Ground Barley, 3,222,563 (3,023,815) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 24,701,436 (38,767,735) pounds.

Total flour stocks for the month of July, 1937 amounted to 988,527 barrels compared with 985,762 barrels for the same month last year and 1,032,056 barrels for the previous month.


