Ottawa, Canada, December 1, 1938. The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for October, 1938, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for October, 1936 amounted to 92,069 barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of October, 1938, 8,531,847 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 6,626,888 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. In the coarse grain group, oats, barley and mixed grain were higher than for October, 1937, while corn and buckwheat were lower.

Grains ground for the month of October, 1938 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat 8,531,847 (6,626,888); Oats 1,851,679 (1,291,496); Corn 272,930 (306,272); Barley 138,263 (135,337); Buckwheat 23,907 (25,383); and Mixed Grain 1,643,733 (1,460,519).

Mill stocks of wheat on October 31, 1938 amounted to 4,451,326 bushels, while for the same month in 1937 the amount was 5,353,537 bushels.

Flour production in October, 1938 amounted to 1,906,385 barrels compared with 1,489,185 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in October, 1938 amounted to 528,601 barrels compared with 336,478 barrels in October, 1937.

Flour production for the month of October, 1938 amounted to 1,906,385 barrels compared with 1,489,185 barrels for the same month last year. This was the highest October production since 1930 and exceeded the manufacture for September by 267,154 barrels. Canadian exports of flour in October reached a total to all countries of 528,601 barrels. Percentage of operation for the month of October was 83.5 as against 63.9 for the corresponding month last year. There was a noticeable decrease in the number of bushels of United States wheat used this month by Canadian mills.

Millfeed manufacture improved in proportion to flour with bran 28,344 (20,338) tons, shorts 28,477 (24,136) tons and middlings 9,291 (5,661) tons.

A decided improvement was evident in the cereal production group. The amounts for October, 1938 were as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 1,565,732 (688,108); Rolled Oats, 23,547,039 (15,747,667); Corn Flour and Meal, 3,063,773 (2,476,304); Fot and Fearl Barley, 645,722 (563,411); and Buckwheat Flour, 392,668 (414,296).

Animal feed production declined from the previous year in the cats, corn and barley items, but was balanced with the increased grind in mixed grain feed. Comparison was as follows: Ground Cats, 9,006,331 (9,470,424) pounds; Cracked Corn, 7,374,037 (10,581,126) pounds; Ground Barley, 4,500,811 (5,379,907) pounds; and Mixed Grain, 72,900,345 (65,419,388) pounds.

Tetal flour stocks amounted to 966,788 barrels compared with 1,203,984 barrels in October, 1937 and 890,878 barrels for last month.


