CANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

May, 1938.

Ottawa, Canada, June 30, 1938. The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes, herewith, preliminary statistics of grains ground and products for May, 1938, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat flour exports.

The daily capacity reporting for May, 1938 amounted to 93,910 barrels.

SUMMARY

During the month of May, 1938, 4,416,909 bushels of wheat were ground in Canadian mills compared with 4,046,207 bushels for the corresponding month of the previous year. Oats, corn and buckwheat were lower than for May, 1937, while barley and mixed grain were higher.

Grains ground for the month of May, 1938 are shown in bushels with comparative figures for the same month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat 4,416,909 (4,046,207); Oats 644,602 (699,640); Corn 188,684 (270,001); Barley 73,531 (68,529); Buckwheat 2,609 (3,052); and Mixed Grain 1,201,292 (817,310).

Mill stocks of wheat on May 31, 1938 amounted to 2,299,305 bushels, while for the same month in 1937 the amount was 6,822,773 bushels.

Flour production in May, 1938 amounted to 977,740 barrels compared with 900,288 barrels for the same month last year. Exports of flour in May, 1938 amounted to 297,126 barrels compared with 348,866 barrels in May, 1937.

Flour production for the month of May, 1938 amounted to 977,740 barrels as compared with 900,288 barrels for the same month last year. Wheat offal varied from last year but showed an increase in the aggregate with bran 15,153 (14,309) tons, shorts 13,853 (14,323) tons and middlings 5,466 (4,206) tons.

Cereal production for May, 1938 was as follows with figures for the same month last year in brackets and the quantities in pounds: Oatmeal, 441,461 (598,640); Rolled Oats, 6,159,367 (6,956,137); Corn Flour and Meal, 3,045,902 (1,910,510); Pot and Pearl Barley, 60,961 (163,278); and Buckwheat Flour 41,972 (49,176).

Compared with last year animal feed products were as follows: Ground Oats, 7,672,010 (7,838,373) pounds; Cracked Corn, 4,990,250 (8,336,006) pounds; Ground Barley, 3,362,067 (2,903,017) pounds; and Mixed Grain 53,507,561 (36,561,969) pounds.

Total flour stocks for the month of May, 1938 amounted to 907,110 barrels compared with 1,029,409 barrels for the same month last year and 967,516 barrels for the previous month.


