## GANADIAN MILLING STATISTICS

May, 1938 .
Ot tawa, Canada, Jone 30, 1938. - The Dominion Bureau of Stetiatice publisher, berewith, prelininary statistics of graine ground and producte for May, 1938, with comparisons for the previous year, inventory for the month and wheat tlour orports.

The daily oapacity reporting for May, 1938 amounted to 93,910 barrela.
SUM MARY
During the month of May, 1938, 4,416,909 bushels of wheat were ground in Cenadisn fill compered with 4,046,207 buabels for the corresponding month of the previous year. Oate, corn and buckweat were lower than for May, 1937, while barley and mixed grain were higher.

Graine ground for the montb of May, 1938 are shown in buehels with comparative figures for the aam month of the previous year in brackets: Wheat $4,416,909(4,046,207)$; 0ats $644,602(699,640)$; Corn 188,684 $(270,001)$; Barley 73,531 (68,529); Buckwheat 2,609 (3,052); and M1xed Gra1n 1,201,292 (817,310).

M111 stocks of wheat on May 31, 1938 amounted to $2,299,305$ bushels, while for the same month in 1937 the suount was $6,822,773$ busbele.

Flour production in May, 1938 amounted to 977,740 barrels compared with 900,288 barrela for the aano month lat year. Exports of flour in May, 1938 amounted to 297,126 barrele compared with 348,866 barrels in May, 1937.

Flour production for the month of May, 1938 amounted to 977,740 barrels as compared with 900,288 barrela for the same month last year. Wheat offal varied fram last year but showed an increase in the aggregate whth bran $15,153(14,309)$ tome, shorts $13,853(14,323)$ tons and middlings $5,466(4,206)$ tons,

Cereal production for Nay, 1938 was as follows with figures for the game month last year in brackete and the quantities in pounds: Oetmeal, 441,461 ( 598,640 ); Rolled oats, 6,159,367 (6,956,137); Corn Flour and Meal, $3,045,902(1,910,510)$; Pot and Pearl Barley, 60,961 (163,278); and Buckwheat Plour 41,972 (49,176).

Compared with last year animal feed products were as follows: Ground 0ats, $7,672,010(7,836,373)$ pounds; Cracked Cora, 4,990,250 (8,336,006) pounds; Ground Barley, 3,362,067 (2,903,017) pounds; and M1xed Grain $53,507,561(36,561,969)$ pounds.

Total Ilour 8 tocks for the honth of May, 1938 amounted to 907,110 barrels compared with $1,089,409$ barrels for the same month last year and 967,516 barrels for the previous month.
